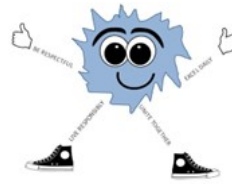

Important Information from our Health Office!

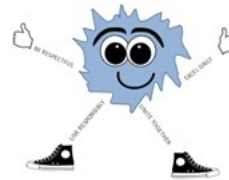
Dear Parent/Guardian:

New York State Education Law allows for sunscreen in the school setting with the following conditions:

1. Parent/Guardian provides and allows the student to self-carry sunscreen to school.
2. Must provide FDA approved sunscreen for the use of avoiding overexposure to the sun and not for medical treatment of an injury or illness. **Aerosol/spray sunscreens are NOT permitted at school.**
3. Please be aware that your child will need to apply the sunscreen to themselves. Staff members are not allowed to apply the sunscreen.
4. Due to allergy and safety precautions, please make sure your student knows they cannot share their sunscreen with other students.

Please be aware the school will not be able to provide sunscreen to your child, it must be provided by the parent/guardian. Please call the health office with any questions!

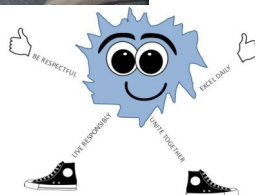


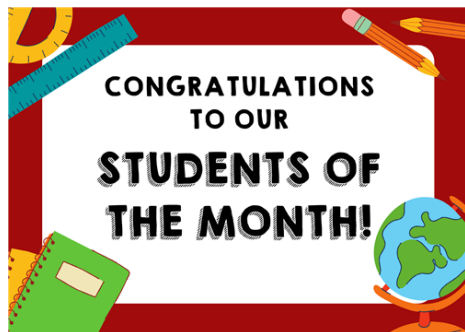

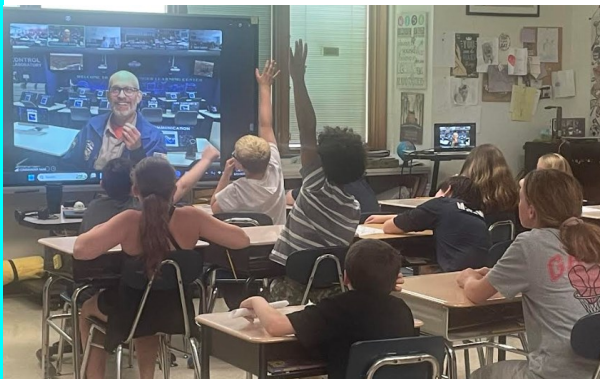


Our BLUE Bash theme last month was Unite Together! . We were lucky to have Gizeli, a Zumba Instructor, unite us all through some dances and songs.
