 - ☐ At least 10 **Pencils** (#2 and mechanical)
 - ☐ At least 5 **Pens** (blue or black)
 - ☐ 1 Hand-held manual pencil **sharpener**
 - ☐ 1 Pack of **colored pencils** (12 colors)
 - ☐ 1 Pack of **Crayola crayons** (12 colors)
 - ☐ 1 Pack of **Markers**
 - ☐ At least 2 **Highlighters** (different colors)
 - ☐ 1 Pair of blunt tipped **scissors**
- ☐ 1 Small **stapler**
- ☐ 1 **Ruler** (12 inch w/ centimeters)
- ☐ 1 Pack of **Index cards** (3x5, white, unruled, 100 per pack)
- ☐ 1 Pack of **Post-It Notes** (any size)

- ☐ 1 Pair of **head-phones/earbuds** or other personal listening device that connects to laptop.
