Title III Update <i>Actualización del Título III</i>	<p>Information was shared about the Title III Plan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title III funds are federal funds used to support English learners • Funds are used to help English learners become proficient in English and meet standards • Sunnyside will receive approximately \$224,000
LCAP	<p>Information was shared about the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and DELAC members were asked to identify activities they have seen at sites as well as needs.</p> <p>Goal 2: Ensure school and classroom environments support social-emotional well-being.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities: Several schools have Project Cornerstone ABC Readers • Need: Social-Emotional Learning for newcomers <p>Goal 3: Emphasize literacy instruction for all students, and specifically for English learners, to deepen student skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities: Reading partners, TK program: students making a lot of progress. Ellis is doing Readers Workshop. Teachers encouraging students to read, Read Naturally program • Need: ELs do better in elementary school, but struggle in middle school with writing. Focus more on writing in earlier grades.
