Did you know?

Children age 5-11 are spending 4-5 hours a day on screens during summer months (source: Common Sense Media)

 Although many apps have 'kid' versions (YouTube Kids) - these platforms still have many pitfalls that allow for toxic content and viewing addiction

• YOUTUBE TIP! SafeVision is a FREE app that allows parents to select up to 5 channels for FREE. No more

wondering what your kids will click on next. See a list of recommended channels for kids <u>here</u>.

Prioritize free play. Set screen time limits and tech free hours of the day. Establish family rules, like no screens at dinner or in the bedrooms.

Use screen time for co-educational content, not solo scrolling.



KNOW ABOUT The Surgeon General advises that no children under the

age of 13 should be using Social Media. Social Media is ANY app or platform that enables users to create and share content or to particpate in social networking.



TikTok: Algorithmic video feed, may show adult content. Short reel format creates addictive behavior. This is true of any reel content.



Snapchat. Messages disappear, difficult to supervise. Main app for sextortion and narcotic solicitation. Prime source of bullying.

Roblox: In-game chat, lots of adult content since oms are user generated. Watch for friend many ro requests from unknown users.

SMARTPHONE ALTERNATIVES

Gizmo watch: Smartwatch with parent approved contact lists. No browser access.

Bark/Pinwheel/Gabb phones - Built in parent supervision. Helps kids learn how to use tech more slowly.

Bark monitoring: Monitoring software for Smartphones.

Gryphon Router (at home): Parental controls for all web activity on Wifi. Most robust and failsafe controls for browsers and devices.

Information about Excused/Unexcused Absences

Attendance Natics Every student. Every day.

The New Jersey Department of Education recognizes only six allowable reasons for an "excused" absence; these reasons are listed below.

- 1. Religious holidays (Each year, the State Board of Education votes on a list of approved religious holidays for observance upon the written request signed by the parent.).
- 2. Participation in observance of Veterans Day.
- 3. Participation in district board of election membership activities.
- 4. Take Our Children to Work Day.
- 5. College visit(s), up to three days per school year for students in grades 11 and 12.
- 6. Closure of a busing school district that prevents a student from having transportation to the receiving school.

Being present and on-time to school each day is extremely important for students' success and well-being. School attendance is a powerful predictor of student outcomes; data shows that, when students are present daily, they learn better and are generally healthier. **Attendance matters and every school day counts!**




