T. DeWitt Taylor Middle-High School has determined that the following criteria must be met in order to earn off campus privilege:

1. Current GPA 2.0 **and** have a minimum of 5 credits.
2. Purchase a **\$25** Lunch Pass. Continued use of lunch pass will be reassessed each quarter for appropriate number of credits and GPA.
3. Grade of F" or "I" on 1st, 2nd, or 3rd Quarter Report Card or GPA dropping below required 2.0 will result in loss of lunch pass privilege.
4. Students must have signed parent/guardian permission on file.

Off-Campus lunch permission is a privilege, not a right, and may be suspended or revoked by the student's parent or school administrator. Listed below are some of the reasons off campus permission **will be** revoked for current grading period and/or remainder of school year.

	Parent Initials	Student Initials
1. Student is tardy/late from lunch more than 5 times in a grading period.		
2. Student transports an unauthorized student who does not have a lunch pass.		
3. Misconduct related to off-campus privilege.		
4. Loitering in the parking lot.		
5. Administrator discretion due to discipline infractions.		

Note: There will be a \$5 charge for a lost off-campus lunch ID.
