CAC meeting:

Special Education Director, Kendy Anderson, provided an overview of the organizational structure and services provided by the Special Education Department.

The primary goals included Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) to identified students and Child Find which is a structured process to identify students who qualify for specially design instruction.

Ms. Anderson explained the budget, IEP process and parent supports. As students get older, some transition out of needing special education services.

Kevin Hook, Director of Transportation, provided an overview of the transportation department.

Transportation by the numbers:

- The Transportation Department is projected to spend \$19,000,000 for the 162 bus routes this year.
- 162 route buses will travel about 20,000 miles this year.

The department utilizes multiple systems for cameras and GPS.
