The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Minutes from the April meeting were approved.

Dr. Gruver, Blueprint and Community Coordinator, provided a presentation on Blueprint for Maryland's Future: The CCPS Implementation Plan. There are five Pillars to the Blueprint:

1. Improving Early Childhood Education

Blueprint Aim: To have a system where all young children and families receive the health, mental health, financial and social supports they need to ensure that students who arrive at the school door healthy and ready to learn.

- Cultivating High-Quality and Diverse Teachers and Leaders
 Blueprint Aim: To have a system that elevates the teaching profession to the high status that it deserves in
 which students are taught by teachers with strong content knowledge who have apprenticed with and been
 mentored by exceptional teachers to hone their craft.
- 3. Ensuring that all Student are College and Career Ready
 Blueprint Aim: To have an engaging and rigorous K-12 instructional system that enables all students to
 reach a college and career readiness standard by 10th grade, and no later than high school graduation, to
 ensure their success in the State's community colleges without the need for remediation.
- 4. More Resources for Students to be Successful Blueprint Aim: To ensure that all students, especially those that may need the most support, have access to no-academic (e.g., social-emotional, behavioral, and health services), academic, and special education support needed to be successful so that students are healthy and able to earn and participate fully in school.
- 5. Governance & Accountability
 Blueprint Aim: To have governance and accountability that supports the effective functioning of the
 education system and monitors how schools and the system are implementing the Blueprint policies and the
 impact they have on student and system performance.

The room was divided up into groups. One group or each pillar. They were asked to review the information for their pillar and identify key information. Each group was asked collaborate and discuss why their pillar is the most valuable pillar.

Each group was given five minutes to share why their group believed that their pillar was the MVP.

Pillar 3 was voted the most valuable pillar.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
