

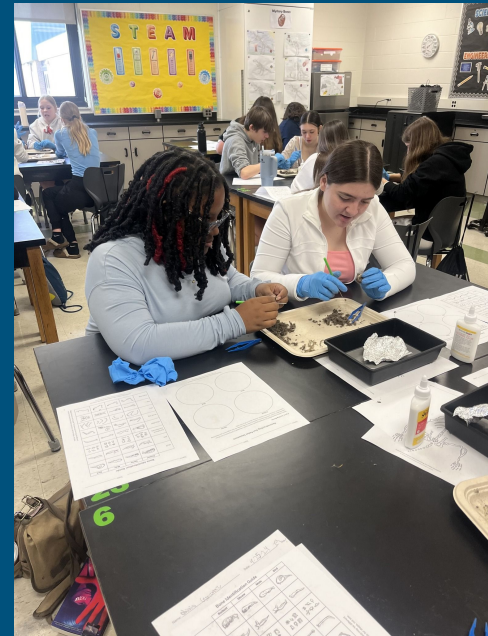
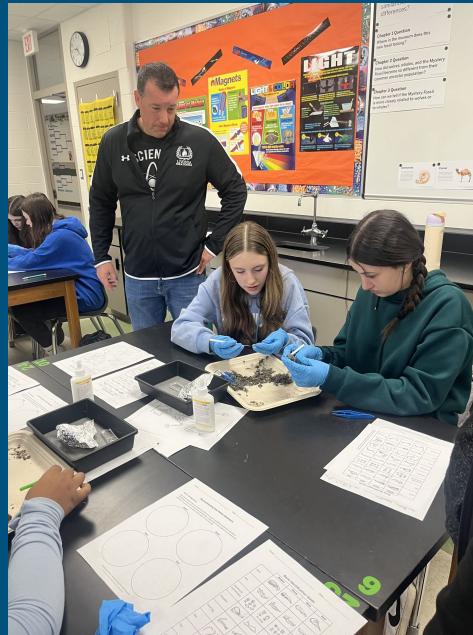
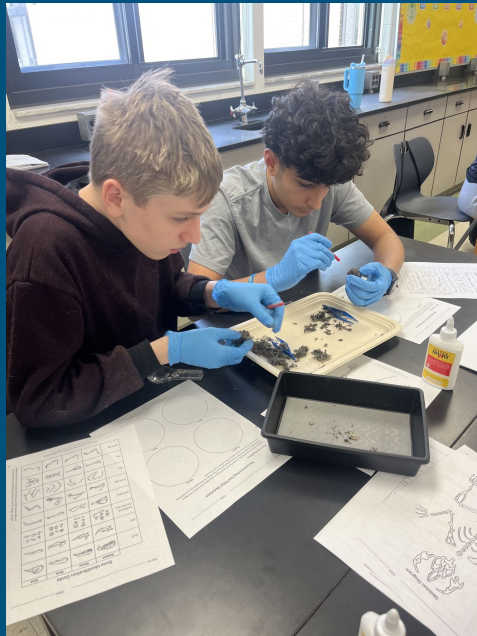

Eagle Scout Project

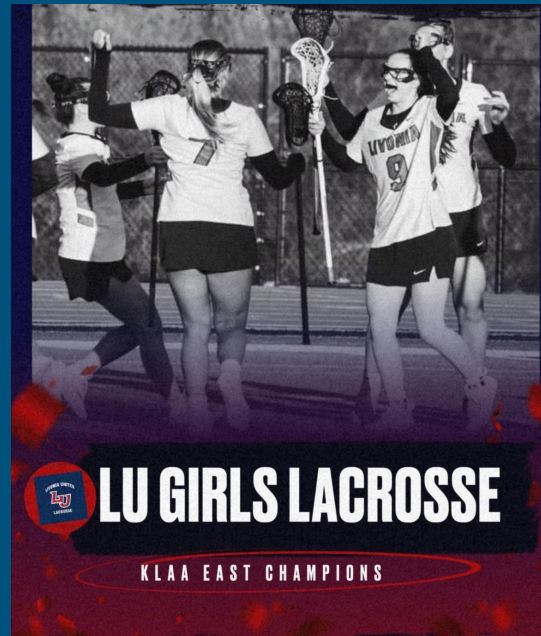

Way to go, Graham!

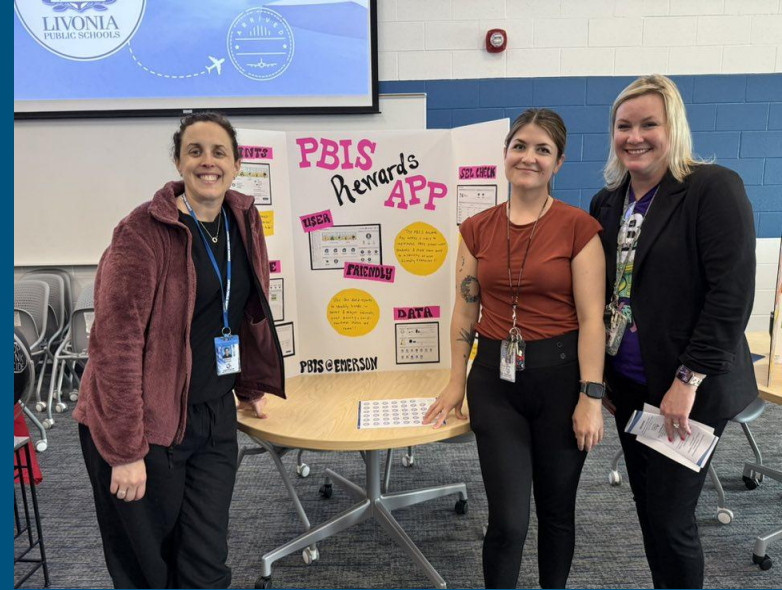


Unified Lacrosse Champions!
