4. Describe the action steps the school/district will take to reduce the opportunity gap in student possession of ASB cards and/or participation in extracurricular activities for the upcoming school year.

ASB Cards:
 Participation in athletics and clubs require ASB card purchase. Cost to the student is based on F/R status. We plan to communicate that if you qualify you can get your ASB card for free- which allows you to participate in athletics and clubs.
 We will not require ASB or discount entrance w/ASB to events such as dances and non-athletic events. Student purchase price for Dances and Plays will be based on F/R status of the student if purchased in advance.
 Athletic events that take a gate: admission is free for students w/ASB, students w/o ASB pay the student rate.

Plans for reducing the opportunity gap.
 Communicating with students and families about ASB card purchases as well as enrollment in F/R and the 1660 waiver.
 At 8th grade move up day and Jack Days we will have a table for both ASB and athletics.
 At Jack days and open house, we will have a table set up for filling out F/R and 1660 waiver.
 Class advisors helping families with paperwork.
 Club advisors will work with their members to get ASB Cards purchased.
 We will continue to offer events that are low cost or free to all students.
 Prior to each sports season we will hold sports meetings during Advisory instead of after school. This way transportation isn't an obstacle for students interested in athletics.
 We will also continue to have a club showcase in advisory to promote participation.
 All announcements/screens/social media are in both English and in Spanish
 We will continue to offer an activity bus to reduce transportation obstacles for activities and athletics- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday.
