2025-26 Supply List – Grade 7

General Supplies

- 2 two-inch binders - label one AM and the other PM
 - Loose leaf paper
 - 2 packs of dividers
- 1 one subject notebook - wide or college ruled
- 1 personal homework planner (one with daily space for assignments)
- 7 two pocket folders - Label with the appropriate class and your name!
- 3 large boxes of tissues to be given to the homeroom teacher
- Wired headphones (No "air pods")
- 3 hole canvas pencil case. Place the following inside:
 - #2 pencils (2 boxes)
 - Pens (1 box)
 - Highlighters (3 colors)
 - Erasers
 - 3 x 3 Post it Notes in a light color (2 packs)
 - One pack of colored pencils (12 pack)
 - One pack of 3x5 index cards (ruled)

Mathematical Supplies

Calculator

- Algebra 7: TI-84 Plus / TI-84 Plus CE
- One box of fine tip dry erase markers

World Language

- Supplies will vary by teacher and will be communicated at the start of the year.

- **Students should ensure they maintain their supplies throughout the school year and replenish as needed.**
- **Students do not need to bring in all of these items on the first day.**
- **Teachers may require additional items.**

Supply List: Performing Music Classes

Band:

- 1 inch 3-ring binder with dividers
- 4 pencils with binder pencil case
- Loose-leaf notebook paper
- Individual instrument needs (reeds, valve oil, sticks/mallets, etc.)

Chorus:

- Sturdy 2-pocket folder with center clips (or 3 ring binder w/pockets) containing:
 - loose-leaf paper
 - pencils

Orchestra:

- 1-inch 3-ring binder
- 2 pencils with binder pencil case
- Rosin, to be kept in instrument case

Performance Attire - Music

For our Winter and Spring concerts, students must have proper concert attire as follows:

- Students should dress in all **black** dress clothing. This includes: black dress pants, black collared dress shirts or blouses, skirts/dresses, and black shoes/socks.
- Not allowed: Polo shirts, T-shirts, jeans, leggings (unless worn with skirt), shorts, Capri pants, short skirts, sneakers.
- The purpose of concert attire is to draw attention to the ensemble, but not to any one individual. Our concert attire must always be neat and clean and must follow the TMS dress code at all times.
