Current Population

- PK-6 Total Population of BRS: 875
- Pre-School: **19** students (Special Ed/ General Ed)
- Students Receiving Special Education: 119 (13.6% prevalence)

Comparing Eval Rates

Last year (23-24)

70 initial referrals

- 30 did not result in evaluation, 40 moved to assessment
- Of the 40 evaluations, 23 were eligible for special education (57.5%)

This year (24-25)

63 initial referrals

- 25 did not result in evaluation, 38 moved to assessment
- Of 38 evaluations- 20 were eligible for special education (53%) (currently 7 open evaluations)

Staffing

- Certified: Fully staffed, with the exception of .5 Psychologist
- Paraeducators: Currently 3 openings (Due to resignations)
- Though the IDEA grant:
 - Sped Teacher (1.0)
 - Speech Pathologist (.7)
 - Part of Sped Teacher
 - Part of Social Worker
 - Part of PreK Teacher
 - Part of Paraeducator
- If rising needs continue, we will need to increase Speech to 1.0 and add an additional Special Education Teacher (for 26-27)

MTSS/SRBI

MTSS (Multi-tiered Systems of Support)

- Updating process to align with the state
- Work group for summer to continue to work on the MTSS Manual
- Parent participation in the process and guidance for families with concerns
- Using State Manual as framework and adjusting to make it user friendly at Beecher
- Revision to the referral process/timeline for intervention
