

<u>News Release – Fatal Car vs Pedestrian MVA</u> <u>Updated 6.2.25 1200PM</u>

Summary:

The West Hartford Police Department responded to a car vs pedestrian motor vehicle accident at the intersection of New Britain Avenue at South Main Street. The pedestrian was found to be unresponsive.

Details:

On 6/1/2025 at 9:49 PM, West Hartford Police, Fire and EMS were dispatched to the intersection of New Britain Avenue at South Main Street for a car vs pedestrian motor vehicle accident. The pedestrian was located on New Britain Avenue just west of South Main Street, unresponsive. Despite lifesaving medical efforts, the pedestrian was pronounced deceased at the scene. The West Hartford Police accident reconstruction team was called to investigate the accident.

The pedestrian was identified as 63 year old Stephen Mendelsohn of New Britain, CT.

The driver of the involved vehicle, 28 year old Alexis Wilson of Bristol, CT, remained on scene and was cooperative in the investigation.

The accident is still under active investigation and no arrests have been made at this time.
