



**Sex Education Advisory Board (SEAB)
Community Report
April 2022 - April 2023**

The following is a summary of the progress of the Sex Education Advisory Board (SEAB). Meetings were held: April 28, 2022, May 19, 2022, September 13, 2022, November 15, 2022, January 17, 2023, February 28, 2023.

Progress:

- Established “community agreements” and consensus protocol.
- Reviewed Michigan Department of Education’s roles, responsibilities, and “Summary of Legal Obligations” for public school Sex Education Advisory Boards (SEAB).
- Reviewed formerly established program goals and curriculum.
- Reviewed available data for the 2021-2022 Michigan Profile for Healthy Youth (MiPHY).
- Considered updates to the K-12 Sexual Health Education curriculum, including:
 - Updates to instructional slides on biological changes during puberty, to be used during 4th grade instruction.
 - HIV/AIDs lesson plans for instruction in grades 4-6.
 - Guest speaker from Sexual Assault Services, Bronson Battle Creek, to provide instruction in grades K-11 on healthy relationships, body safety, and trusted adults.
 - Pregnancy video for 7th grade instruction.
 - Guest speaker from Michigan State Police to provide instruction to grades 7-8 on Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM) and internet safety.
- Presented proposed curriculum updates to the Lakeview Board of Education during two public hearings held on March 20, 2023 and April 17, 2023. The Lakeview Board of Education approved the recommended updates on April 17, 2023.

Next Steps for 2023 - 2024:

- Continue reviewing curriculum updates, as proposed by the district K-12 health educators.
