



**Sex Education Advisory Board (SEAB)
Community Report
July 2023 - June 2025**

The following is a summary of the progress of the Lakeview School District Sex Education Advisory Board (SEAB) meetings, held on the following dates:

- January 24, 2024
- February 21, 2024
- April 22, 2025

Progress:

- Considered staff recommendations for the K-12 Human Sexuality curriculum, including:
 - Guest presenter from Grace Health to co-teach with Lakeview High School teachers, on the following board-approved topics: substance abuse, mental health, sexual health and other struggles in grades.
 - Adoption of the Elevatus Curriculum for teaching human sexuality to high school students with cognitive impairments.
 - Adoption of the Rights, Respect, and Responsibility lessons for students in grades 7-8.
- All of these recommendations were supported by the SEAB, and will go to the Lakeview Board of Education for their consideration.

Next Steps for 2025 - 2026:

- Seek the Lakeview Board of Education's approval on the aforementioned instructional resources. This process requires two public hearings that will take place in July 2025 and August 2025 before Board of Education discussion and vote.
- Identify SEAB members for a renewed three-year term, per the Lakeview SEAB By-Laws.
- Study MiPHY Survey data trends for students in grades 7, 9 and 11 in order to set program goals.
- Consider any future requests brought forth by district staff for instructional resources.
