Elementary Summer School and Kindergarten Readiness

Program Dates: 7/14/2025 - 8/7/2025 (16 days)

(ES Course Selection is the grade level student will be in the following September.)

- 4 days per week (Monday-Thursday)
- Students will be in attendance from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- Focus will be on ELA and Mathematics
- Will continue to infuse Social Emotional Learning components into the program
- Students will receive a progress notice at the end of the program

 - o **Location:**
 - **New York Mills UFSD**
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- **Driver Education** will be made available to interested students from participating school districts
 - o Participating school districts as of this date:
 - Holland Patent, Waterville, Clinton, Oriskany, Brookfield, New York Mills
 - o **Program Dates: 7/07/2025 - 8/22/2025**
 - o Instructional times and driving times will be determined at the start of the program by the driving instructors in conjunction with registered students and their families.
 - o Driver Education students must be 16 or older and produce a valid driver's license or learner's permit. The school district is responsible for securing this information and must send copies to OHM BOCES prior to the first day of instruction. **Students will not be able to start this program until a driver's license or permit has been sent to OHM BOCES.**
 - o Only students from participating school districts may register.
 - **Requirements to successfully complete Driver Education are as follows:**
 - o 24 Hours of Classroom Driver Ed Instruction (no more than 90 mins creditable per day)
 - o 24 Hours of Driving Instruction (minimum of 6 hours directly behind the wheel instruction; 18 hours of observation time, learning and observing from the backseat; no more than 90 minutes creditable per day).
 - o Demonstration of Learning through successfully completing Unit Quizzes and a Final Exam
 - o Based on these requirements, the Course is organized as such:
 - 16 Classroom Lessons of 90 minutes each
 - 16 Driving Instruction Lessons of 90 minutes each (maximum of 4 students in the DE vehicle)
 - Typically--but not necessarily-- students complete 1 Classroom Lesson and 1 Driving Lesson on the same day (3-hour commitment for 16 days)

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- **Regional Summer School Grading:**
 - o Final grades will be based upon a grade recorded after the first marking, a grade recorded after the second marking period and a final exam grade.

- Marking Periods will be as follows:
 - **Marking Period 1: 7/07/25 - 7/24/25** (unlock date: 7/23, lock date: 7/28, report cards mailed to the school districts: 7/31/25)
 - **Marking Period 2: 7/28/25 - 8/14/25** (unlock date: 8/12, lock date: 8/18, report cards mailed to school districts and families: on or about 8/22/25).
