The students of Mr. Kliniske's fourth grade class will present a donation of more than \$248 to Down Home Founder and Executive Director Jenessa Fillipi on Friday in honor of Red Nose Day.

The students and staff at Eagles raised the money for the donation with a penny war during the week leading up to Red Nose Day on May 22. Each class competed to see which class could raise the most money in their jars, with the winning class earning the right to choose what organization would receive the donation.
