The St. Bernard Parish School Board met as a Committee of the Whole on Tuesday, October 9, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the St. Bernard Parish School Board Office. Following the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the Secretary called the roll. Members present were, Mr. Clifford M. Englande, President, Mr. Donald D. Campbell, Mr. Carl W. Gaines, Jr., Mrs. Diana B. Dysart, Mrs. Katherine K. Lemoine, Mr. Joseph V. Long, Sr., Mr. Shelton P. Smith and Mr. Sean K. Warner. Mrs. Darleen P. Asevedo, Mr. William H. Egan and Dr. Hugh C. Craft were absent.

Mr. Englande welcomed Ms. Alex Schneider to present Super News. Alex first reviewed the October Communications report showing recent news articles and social media activity and statistics. Upcoming events covered included CHS Ring Day and the CHS Homecoming Game.

The Super News brought to the Board tonight highlighted the CHS Alumni Social and the Alumni Association, the St. Bernard Reading Association membership kickoff meeting, Jennie Maldonado being honored at a recent Saints game as Chevron's Teacher of the Week, Walk/Bike Places Conference delegation visit, Maumus Center Planetarium schedule, Old Arabi Sugar Fest, Dietician Interns, Joe Long with Davies School Spotlight, Shelton Smith with Smith Elementary Spotlight, Carl Gaines closed that segment of School Spotlight, Encouragement of future teachers to apply for teaching positions and finally, parent reminder of upcoming Parent/Teacher Conference on October 23<sup>rd</sup> for Elementary Schools, October 24 for Middle Schools and Rowley Alternative and October 25 for Chalmette High. An additional note provided a "shout out" to Board Member Katherine Lemoine

who was recently honored with the President's Award by the Louisiana Community and Technical Colleges Association for excellence in teaching.

Mr. Englande thanked Ms. Schneider, Barry Lemoine and Jack Jackson for their time and energy in producing the Super News.

Mr. Englande next welcomed Mr. Charles Cassar to present information concerning the upcoming Red Ribbon Week. Mr. Cassar noted that the national and local effort to reduce drug activity will take place from October 23 – 31, 2018. The theme this year is "Life is your Journey so travel Drug Free." Mr. Cassar noted that rally activities and speakers will be presented throughout the school system during this week. One of those projects will be a mock crash that will be held Friday, October 12, 2018 at the St. Bernard Middle School athletic field. The 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> graders at Chalmette High will be bussed to St. Bernard Middle to view the mock crash. 8<sup>th</sup> graders at St. Bernard Middle will also be allowed to attend. This event is intended to cover the impact of driving while under the influence and cell phone distractions.

Mr. Englande and the Committee thanked Mr. Cassar for his efforts in this arena and for his presentation tonight.

Mr. Englande next asked Mr. Gaines to chair the Education Committee item with Ms. Voitier to present her annual report on the status of each schools Crisis Management and Response Plans. Ms. Voitier noted that our school Crisis Management and Response Plans have been reviewed by the staff and by the stakeholders involved, any necessary revisions to the plans have been made and within the first 30 days of the school year, each and every one of our schools have conducted safety drills to rehearse the components of the plan. She added that reports were then submitted in writing to the Superintendent to note that the drills were done, what the results were and if any revisions to the plan had to be made.

All questions were addressed by the Superintendent. Mr. Gaines thanked Ms. Voitier for her presentation.

Mr. Gaines next welcomed Assistant Superintendent, Mary Lumetta, to present the following information regarding a recently received grant titled Project AWARE.

The information below was presented along with discussion of how most of this grant would be directed toward delivering additional services at Rowley Alternative School. Other discussion took place regarding services that are also offered to the entire school population and even some self-care strategies for teachers.

# Project AWARE

Louisiana is receiving a Project Advancing Wellness and Resilience Education (Project AWARE) grant through the U.S. Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.

The Louisiana Department of Education, in partnership with the Louisiana

Department of Health (LDH), will utilize this funding to establish a comprehensive Louisiana School Mental Health Support Program.

#### Aims

- instill an understanding of the impact of current and past experiences on the school-aged youth's current behavior and mental health
- promote positive, pro-active engagement strategies to increase student engagement to support the development overall mental health
- provide training to school personnel on how to detect and respond to mental health issues
- provide students struggling with behavioral or mental health issues with services

The three partner LEAs

- St. Bernard Parish Schools
- Jefferson Parish Schools
- Monroe City Schools

St. Bernard Parish will receive \$318,000 each year for 5 years.

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Mr. Granberry presented the Personnel changes for October 2018.
