REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MAY 22, 2018

The St. Bernard Parish School Board met in a Regular Monthly Meeting on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the St. Bernard Parish School Board Office. Following the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the Secretary called the roll. Present were, Mr. Clifford M. Englande, President, Mrs. Darleen P. Asevedo, Mr. Donald D. Campbell, Dr. Hugh C. Craft, Mr. William H. Egan, Mr. Carl W. Gaines, Jr., Mrs. Diana B. Dysart, Mrs. Katherine K. Lemoine, Mr. Joseph V. Long, Sr., and Mr. Sean K. Warner. Mr. Shelton Smith was absent.

The public hearing for the 2018-2019 General Fund and Special Revenue Funds budgets was held. No one appeared to address the Board at the public hearing.

No one wished to address the Board under Community Concerns.

On motion of Mr. Warner, seconded by Mrs. Dysart, the Board voted with no objections by a roll call vote of the members present to incorporate the report of the May 8, 2018 General Committee Meeting into the minutes of the May Regular Monthly Meeting.

GENERAL COMMITTEE REPORT TUESDAY, MAY 8, 2018

The St. Bernard Parish School Board met as a Committee of the Whole on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the St. Bernard Parish School Board Office. Following the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the Secretary called the roll. Present were, Mr. Clifford M. Englande, President, Mrs. Darleen P. Asevedo, Mr. Donald D. Campbell, Dr. Hugh C. Craft, Mr. William H. Egan, Mr. Carl W. Gaines, Jr., Mrs. Diana B. Dysart, Mrs. Katherine K. Lemoine, Mr. Joseph V. Long, Sr., Mr. Shelton P. Smith and Mr. Sean K. Warner.

Mr. Englande announced the next agenda item, the recognition of the National Academic Games Team. Academic Games Coordinator, Mary Lumetta, began the presentation by applauding team members and showing the trophies they won to the Board. She then expressed her gratitude to the parents, coaches and especially Chalmette Refinery – PBF Energy for their generosity in sponsoring the team's trip to the national tournament as well as the awards for local tournaments and shirts for the team.

All the coaches and team members received proclamations from the President of the Board, Mr. Clifford Englande, for their outstanding achievements at the 2018 Academic Games National Competition in Knoxville, Tennessee.

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Mrs. Lemoine as Education Committee Chair welcomed Mr. Tommie Powell, Supervisor of Child Welfare and Attendance, to review changes to the Guide to Student Conduct.

Mr. Powell presented the changes to the Guide to Student Conduct for the 2018-2019 school year. He addressed all the questions and concerns the committee had regarding these changes.

Dr. Craft moved to recommend to the Board to approve the changes to the Guide to Student Conduct for the 2018 -2019 school year as presented by Mr. Powell. Seconded by Mrs. Asevedo, the motion passed with no objections by a roll call vote of the members present.

The next item on the agenda was addressed by Mr. Long as Executive Committee co-chair. Mr. Granberry presented to the Committee the Personnel Changes for May 2018.

Ms. Voitier took this opportunity to appoint three new Principals. The vacancies were created by the retirement of Dr. Montrelle Sinegar of Andrew Jackson, Mrs. Donna Schultz of Davies Elementary and Mrs. Stacie Alfonso of Lacoste Elementary. Ms. Voitier first announced that Mrs. Tiffani Glapion would be assigned as Principal for Davies Elementary. Her next announcement was for Mrs. Heather Morel as Principal for Lacoste Elementary. Ms. Voitier's final announcement was for Mrs. Andrea Licciardi as Principal of Andrew Jackson Middle School.

Mr. Granberry next presented the Committee with the 2018-2019 Personnel Appointments. Mr. Granberry addressed all questions of the Committee.

Mr. Granberry next presented the Personnel Evaluation Plan with a recommendation for no changes at this time. Mr. Warner moved to accept the Personnel Evaluation Plan as presented tonight with no changes. Seconded by Mrs. Lemoine the motion passed with no objections by a roll call vote of the members present.

Mr. Granberry again addressed the Committee with a request to mail Letters of Assurance for substitutes for the 2018-2019 school year. All questions or comments from the Committee were handled by Mr. Granberry.

Dr. Craft made the motion to recommend to the Board to authorize the Administration to mail the Letters of Assurance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Campbell and passed by a unanimous roll call vote of the members present.

Mr. Egan handled the next agenda item as Insurance Committee Chair. He welcomed Mr. David Fernandez, Finance Manager and Mr. Richard Clements and Mr. Timothy Clements, our agents of record from Clements Insurance, to present the Administration's request for permission to renew flood insurance. Mr. Fernandez presented the worksheet that indicated the prices for each building for the flood insurance stating that the St. Bernard School board is required to maintain maximum flood insurance available from the National Flood Insurance Program on all buildings.

A motion was made by Mr. Warner to recommend to the Board to accept the Administrations recommendation regarding flood insurance coverage for 12

months beginning May 31, 2018. Seconded by Mrs. Dysart, the motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present.

Mrs. Dysart as Finance Committee chair next introduced Mr. Fernandez to present the next agenda item regarding the adoption of 2018 Ad Valorem Millages. Mr. Fernandez stated that Board is required to levy on Ad Valorem properties on a yearly basis. He presented the resolution that outlines the specific millages for the current year.

Mr. Gaines moved to approve the Administration's recommendation to adopt the 2018 Ad Valorem Millages as presented. Seconded by Dr. Craft, the motion passed unopposed by a roll call vote of the members present.

Mr. Fernandez next presented the Proposed Budgets for the 2018-2019 General Fund and Special Revenue Funds. Mr. Fernandez went over each of the highlights of the proposed General Fund and Special Revenue Funds budgets and answered all the Committee's questions.

A motion was made by Dr. Craft to recommend to the Board to approve the 2018-2019 General Fund and Special Revenue Funds budgets. The motion was seconded by Mr. Smith and passed unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present.

Next Mrs. Dysart allowed Mr. Fernandez, in Mrs. Joni Blum's absence, to present the Administration's request to approve the bid tabulation for Milk and Milk products for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

With a motion by Mr. Englande, seconded by Mr. Campbell, the motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present to recommend to the Board to approve the low bidder on the bid tabulation for Milk and Milk products for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

Again, Mrs. Dysart welcomed Mr. Fernandez to present the Administration's request to approve the bid tabulation for Bread and Bread products for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

With a motion by Mr. Gaines, seconded by Mrs. Lemoine, the motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present to recommend to the Board to approve the low qualified bidder on the bid tabulation for Bread and Bread products for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

Under Superintendent's Recommendations Ms. Voitier reminded everyone that before the Regular Monthly Meeting on May 22, 2018 there will be a Public Hearing regarding the 2018 – 2019 General fund and Special Revenue Funds budgets. Mrs. Voitier also reminded everyone about the Chalmette High School Honors Banquet on Friday at 6:30 and then the Graduation on Thursday, May 17, 2018 at the UNO Arena. She also noted that 5th Grade and 8th Grade exit ceremonies will take place on May 23rd and Job Fair for teachers will be on Saturday, May 12, 2018.

On a point of privilege Mr. Long reminded everyone that the St. Claude Bridge will be closed for the next several days so everyone should allow for extra travel time when traveling to the UNO Arena.

There being no further business to discuss and on motion of Mr. Campbell, seconded by Mrs. Asevedo, and passed unanimously by voice vote, the meeting was adjourned.

The committee is also recommending for a long term study on the dress code guidelines.

Additional information for the 2018-2019 Guide to Student Conduct

Driving is a Privilege (R.S. 32:431) The 2003 Legislative Session provides for the suspension of driving privileges of a student who is expelled or suspended from school for ten (10) or more consecutive school days for committing certain infractions. The infractions listed below are the only suspendable/expellable offenses:

- 1. Sale/Possession of drugs, alcohol, or other illegal substance
- 2. Possession of a firearm
- 3. An infraction involving assault or battery on a member of the school faculty or staff

The principal shall notify the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the Office of Motor Vehicles of any student between the ages of 15 and 18 who has been subjected to a disciplinary infraction described above, so that the process of suspension of driving privileges of a student may occur. The Office of Motor Vehicles will suspend for one (1) year the driver's license. The suspension will not exceed the student's 18th birthday. A hardship license may be requested by the student to drive to and from school, work, a drug or alcohol treatment counseling program or a mental health treatment program when no other transportation is available. If after six (6) months of suspension the student displays exemplary behavior, the principal may send a signed letter on official school letterhead stating this and the suspension of the student's license

will end.
