As we approach the conclusion of the academic year, we would like to inform you about the endof-year procedures for student devices. Specifically, regarding the return of devices for the graduating 4th-grade students who will be transitioning to a new building. It is important that these students return their assigned devices, along with all accompanying accessories, to their current building during the week of June 16th. Please ensure that both the device and its charger are included in the return. Any device not received by June 20th will result in a device fine of \$251.

For the remaining 2nd and 3rd graders, who will soon become our esteemed 3rd and 4th graders, they will have the opportunity to take their devices home at the end of the year. This will allow them to adequately prepare for the upcoming academic term and be fully equipped on the first day of school.

#### KINDERGARTEN SCREENING

**Dear Incoming Kindergarten Parents,** 

We are very excited to welcome your child to Kindergarten in September. As part of the registration process, we would like to offer you an opportunity to have your child visit a kindergarten classroom in June. During this visit, students will engage in typical kindergarten classroom activities such as reading books, playing games and drawing. Various school staff will engage with your child so we can learn more about your child's kindergarten readiness. Kindergarten classroom visits will be held on June 4 only.

While your child is visiting Kindergarten, we ask that a parent remain at the school. While you are waiting for your child, you will have an opportunity to informally meet the principal and share some information about your child that you would like the school to know. All information gathered during this visit is intended to help the school best prepare to welcome your child to school in September.

Please call the Main Office (732-613-6830) in order to schedule a time for this screening visit. For security purposes, visits must be pre-scheduled and parent photo identification is required.

\*Students already enrolled in the district's preschool or ELA program do not need to attend Kindergarten screening (screenings will be conducted during their school day).


