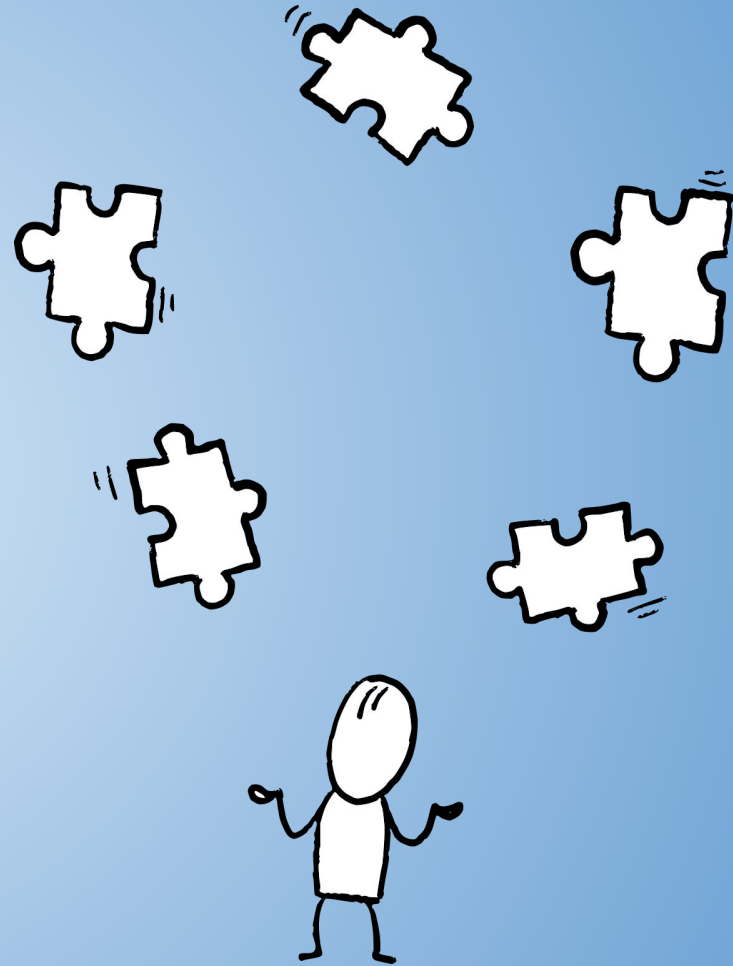

# *Advanced Placement*

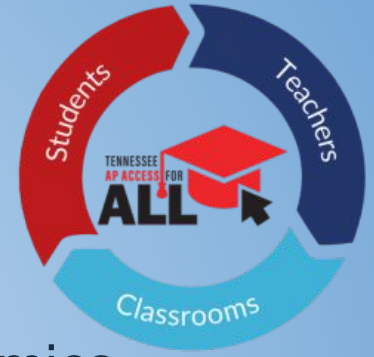


- Allow students to take college level coursework
- AP scores may translate to college credit (scores of 3+)
- Exam fee = \$99\*
- AP Seminar & AP Research Exam fee = \$147\*
- Exams take place in May

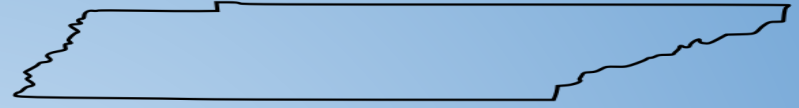

  - Bio, Chem/Physics, and 1 more lab science
- Social Studies .....3 cr
  - W. History, US History, US Gov't/Econ
- Wellness..... 1 cr
- Physical Education...0.5 cr
- Foreign Language .....2 cr
- Fine Arts .....1 cr
- Personal Finance.... 0.5 cr
- Focus Electives .....3 cr
- General Electives .....4 cr
  - One of these must be Computer Science for ***incoming*** freshman
