On a point of privilege, Ms. Lemoine and the Board wished Mr. Jack Jackson of PEN TV a very Happy 40th Birthday.

Ms. Voitier, also on a point of privilege, asked for a moment of silence to honor the passing of Ms. Eve Ziegler who was a teacher at Smith Elementary. After the moment of silence, condolences were offered to friends and family of Ms. Ziegler.

The St. Bernard Parish School Board met as a Committee of the Whole on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the St. Bernard Parish School Board Office. On a point of privilege Mrs. Dysart asked for a moment of silence in memory of educators who recently passed, they are; Mr. John Accomando, Ms. Erin Kuehl and Ms. Laura Sullivan all of which were Teachers and/or Principals in our schools. Ms. Dysart asked to remember the son of former Assistant Principal Jack Serigne, Jonathan Serigne, who passed away just last week. Alex first reviewed the October Communications report showing recent news articles and social media activity and statistics from the District Facebook Account. Ms. Schneider also wished to share social media statistics from Chalmette High, Davies Elementary and Arabi Elementary.

HISTORIC CULTURAL

January 9, 2019 Historic Presentation for Battle of N.O.

Mrs. Lemoine and the entire Committee thanked Mr. Cassar for his presentation and additional thanks were offered to the teachers and students participating in these cultural arts activities.

Mr. Long as Executive Committee Chair welcomed Special Education Supervisor, Cheramie Kerth and Nurse Supervisor Laurie McInnis to address the Administration of the medication – Epinephrine. Ms. Kerth explained that by law and within the already adopted School Board policy file JGCD, nurses or a trained employee are allowed to treat what they believe are symptoms of an anaphylactic reaction in students whether or not the student has a prescription for epinephrine. While the law and the Board Policy allowed for the administration of epinephrine the product was not kept on hand in each

school for that purpose. Ms. Kerth noted that soon EpiPens will be provided free of charge to each of our parish schools from Mylan, Inc. through Tulane Hospital. In preparation for the arrival of these EpiPens, on November 1⁹ 2019 a certified physician, Dr. John Carlson from Tulane, will be providing training for nurses and school personnel. Dr. Carlson will also administer the standing protocol for the use of these EpiPens.

Ms. Kerth and Nurse McInnis answered all questions regarding the availability of EpiPens within each school. Mr. Long thanked them for their presentation.

Ms. Voitier presented the Personnel changes for October 2019. Mrs. Dysart thanked Ms. Joyce Lopez and Cynthia Norton for their years of service upon their retirement.

Mr. Warner as chair of the Finance Committee next welcomed Mrs. Joni Blum to present the Administration's request to Advertise for bid for Spices and Seasonings (Class 2), Cereal, Dried Beans and Crackers (Class 3), Frozen Foods (Class 5), Meat and Meat Products (Class 6), Poultry and Eggs (Class 7), Seafood Products (Class 8) and Canned Goods (Class 9) for the period of January 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020. Mr. Smith moved to recommend the Board approve the above request. Seconded by Mrs. Dysart, the motion was approved unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present.
