Here are some of the project areas that you can enter. Your entries can be projects you have made at home or in a class.



Clothing and Textiles

This can be a garment or non-garment item.

Crafts

Items can include ceramics, fabric, yarn, crafts made from a kit, or your own design.

Fine Art

Paintings, drawings, sculptures, and other artwork are included in this category.

Food and Nutrition

Categories include displays, menus, and place settings, dairy foods, international foods, frozen foods, baked goods, canned foods, yeast breads and roll and other foods.

Horticulture

Categories include indoor potted plants, flowers, plant groupings, vegetables, arrangements, vegetable plants in pots, corsages, fruits and berries, and ornamentals.

Literary Work

Categories include poetry, fiction, non-fiction and song lyrics.

Needlework

Categories include knitted item, crocheted item, needlepoint item, embroidery and counted cross stitch, crewel, appliqué, quilting, and rugs.



Photography

Pictures can be digital or film photography.

Pets & Project Posters

Create a poster all about your pet or project and why they are special to you! Pictures, drawing, and stories are encouraged to tell others about it.

Sciences

Categories include forestry, conservation, entomology, marine science, biology/ecology, and earth science/physical science.

Virtual / Digital

Videos, digital art, games, and more.

Miscellaneous

Items that don't fit the other categories. Contact the 4-H office with any questions (morris4h@co.morris.nj.us).
