What is the Humanity First Model? Why Does it Matter?

At its core, the Humanity First model recognizes that the best way to support children is by strengthening the adults in their lives. When we center the well-being, agency, and collaboration of caregivers, educators, and community leaders, we create the conditions for children to thrive.

This model challenges traditional leadership approaches by replacing hierarchy with shared responsibility and isolation with collective learning. It asks us to consider:

- How do we show up for each other as a network of support?
- How do we ensure every voice is heard—especially those who are often left out?
- How do we fuel ourselves and others so we can sustain this important work?

The Humanity First Summer Institute is designed to *fuel the adults in children's lives* — educators, families, caregivers, and leaders — by strengthening the network of relationships that shape children's environments.
