1. Review of Annual Report

2. Facilities Naming Issues

- The committee continued discussion about the Ben Hammerschmidt recognition at the Poly High School Honor Walk and discussed a possible dedication ceremony at the upcoming Homecoming game. Staff said they would investigate the possibility of holding the dedication at that time, but stated it was unsure as construction is currently underway and it was unknown if the project would be completed in time.
- Mrs. Allavie stated that she'd like to work on the wording for a plaque that would go on the wall to honor Mr. Hammerschmidt.
- The committee also continued discussions about a suggestion to name the board room for former Board of Education member Art Littleworth.

- Committee members expressed concern that a second recognition for Mr. Littleworth might diminish the first. The theater at Poly High School is currently named for Art Littleworth.
- Dr. Miller added that it's possible the current location of the Board Room could change over the years and then the honor for Mr. Littleworth at that location would be lost.
- The committee stated that what is important is to preserve the legacy of Mr. Littleworth and his accomplishments for the district, including his leadership during the 1960s, when RUSD desegregated. The committee discussed possibly have a display case in the Littleworth Theater lobby that tells the story.
