2. Graduation Requirements Board Policy Recommendation

Staff provided a recommendation to update the High School Graduation Requirements. Dr. Jamie Angulo explained that we are now aligning to the College and Career indicator. Riverside Unified School District students should, upon graduation, have opportunities that prepare them for postsecondary education and career success. To that end, requirements have been designed to promote choices, whether career or academic, to give every student a springboard to a successful life.

3. High School Fees for Participation in Co/Extra Curricular Activities

Staff provided an update on current policies regarding fees for Co/Extra Curricular activities and the next steps to review current practices. AB1575 signed into law October 2012, added sections 49010-49013 to the Education Code, which codified existing law on student fees and added new complaint procedures for resolving student fee complaints.

4. Head Start Governance Update

Staff provided an annual update regarding the Head Start Governance program.

5. Future Board Presentations

Dr. Ryan Lewis noted some changes to the Academic Oversight Calendar: Move Core Knowledge to 2/27, move RCC CCAP Dual Enrollment to 1/16, and move TK-2 ELA-ELD to 1/16.
