ECISD is providing public notice it will be applying for the 2025-2026 ESSA Consolidated Federal Grant through the Elementary and Secondary Education (ESEA) Act. The following grant entitlements have been approved by the United States Department of Education for Ector County ISD through the Texas Education Agency.

Title I, Part A: Improving the Academic Achievement of Students	\$9,491,437	Provide all children a significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high – quality education and close educational achievement gaps.
Title I, Part D: Neglected/Delinquent Students	\$21,999	Provide neglected and delinquent children a significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high –quality education and close educational achievement gaps
Title II, Part A: Preparing, Training, and Recruiting High-Quality Teachers and Principals	\$1,099,060	Provide educators (teachers, principals and school leaders) support in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure equity of educational opportunity for all students.
Title III, Part A (Immigrant): Language Instruction for English Learners and Immigrant Students	\$69,647	Provide English learners, including immigrant children and youth, the necessary support to attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment in English, and meet the same challenging State academic content and student academic achievement standards as all children are expected to meet.
Title III, Part A – Language Instruction for English Learners and Immigrant Students	\$871,039	Provide English learners, including immigrant children and youth, the necessary support to attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment in English, and meet the same challenging State academic content and student academic achievement standards as all children are expected to meet.
Title IV, Part A – Student Support and Academic Enrichment	\$757,590	Provides funding to improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the capacity of LEAs, schools, and communities to: (1) provide all students with access to a well-rounded education; (2) improve school conditions for student learning; and (3) improve the use of technology and data to enhance academic outcomes and digital literacy of students.
