COSMETOLOGY

COSMETOLOGY REVIEW HOURS

The Cosmetology Review Hours course is designed for individuals who have completed their initial cosmetology training in Oklahoma but have not applied for licensure, registered for the state licensing examination, or failed the exam. This refresher course provides 120 clock hours of instruction in an approved cosmetology school and is required for those who have delayed licensure between one- and five-years post-training. The course focuses on reinforcing core cosmetology skills, updating students on current industry standards and state regulations, and preparing them for the written and practical licensing exams. Completion of this course is essential for regaining eligibility to test and become licensed in Oklahoma.

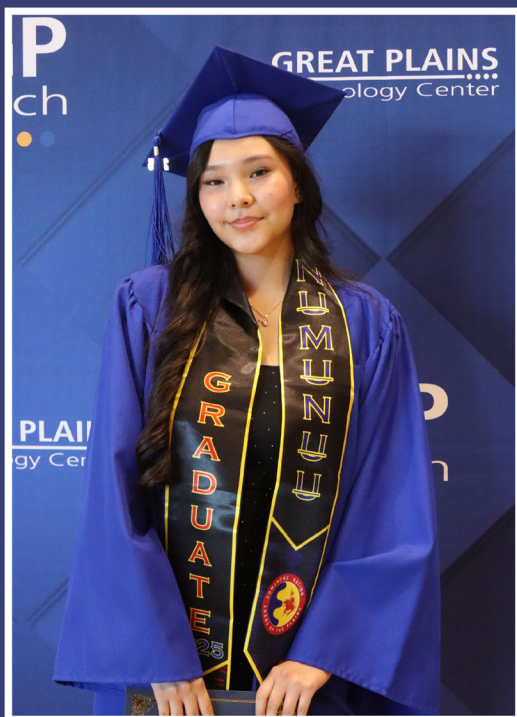

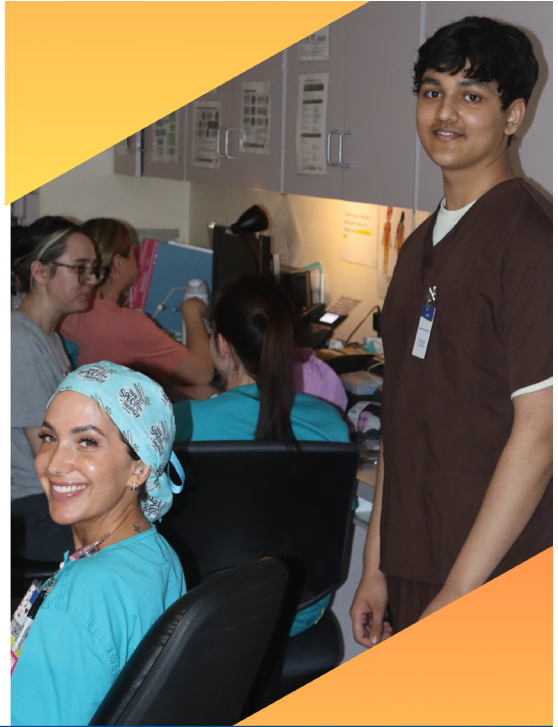

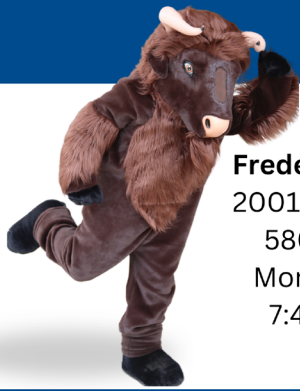

ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES-EVENING CLASSES

- You must be at least 16 years of age to enroll in Adult Career Development Classes, unless otherwise stated in course description.
- Tuition is due in full at time of enrollment.

Reciprocity Agreement

In accordance with the State Board of Oklahoma CareerTech, students enrolling in a part-time class who currently reside within a district served by an Oklahoma Technology Center may enroll at the rates published in this catalog. Any student who does not live within a technology center district will be charged twice the published rate.

Students enrolling in full-time adult programs who do not reside in the Great Plains Technology Center district will be charged the published tuition plus a \$1000 out of district fee.
