ISD 728 Elk River Area School District (ERASD) is the eighth largest school district in Minnesota. We are a progressive district located 35 miles northwest of Minneapolis. We proudly serve approximately 14,352 neighborhood students and more than 50,000 total lifelong learners in all or parts of **Albertville, Dayton, Elk River, Otsego, Ramsey, Rogers, St. Michael, Zimmerman** and the townships of **Big Lake, Baldwin, Burns, Livonia, Nowthen, Orrock** and **Stanford**. Rogers, Minnesota was selected by the national Businessweek magazine as the *“Best place to raise children in Minnesota”* for 2013.

Curriculum

RHS offers a wide variety of courses in order to challenge each student to achieve to his/her potential. Over 167 courses are offered, some at different ability levels. Courses are offered on a semester basis (two semesters a year). Classes are 52 minutes in length, 6 periods in a day, 172 student days per year. Students receive one credit per semester for each course successfully completed (proctors receive .5 credit). No credit is awarded for Advisory. Grading Weights

Grades that students earn in their courses are used to calculate their overall Grade Point Average (GPA). To calculate GPA, grades are assigned Honor Points based on a 4.00 grading scale. Advanced Placement (AP) and concurrent enrollment courses have a high level of difficulty. The grade in one of these courses is awarded more honor points than the same grade in a regular class.
