Attached is a CD with the districtwide Student Disciplinary Action Summary for the 2010–2011 academic year. This report was produced in compliance with Texas Education Code Chapter 39. It is organized according to the coding categories used by the Texas Education Agency and includes a statement of the number, rate, and type of violent or criminal disciplinary incidents that occurred on each campus. Rates were calculated by dividing the number of incidents by the PEIMS Fall Resubmission enrollment. Districtwide, the overall incident rate was 47.58, representing 96,731 incidents. The figures are decreases from the previous year's rate of 50.33 and 101,135 incidents. It must be emphasized that the numbers of incidents are duplicated counts representing the total number of incidents, not the number of students. Consequently, students may be counted more than once. This report supports HISD's Core Initiative 4: Data Driven Accountability.

The report is provided in two formats. In the first format, schools are reported according to their School Board Member Districts. The second format organizes the schools by School Office. A printed copy of the Board Member District Report is provided for your convenience. Previous years' reports are available on-line on the Research and Accountability Department's website on the HISD Portal.

The following four tables present summary level data for the past three academic years for in-school suspensions (**Table 1**), out-of-school suspensions (**Table 2**), removals to the Discipline Alternative Education Program (DAEP) (**Table 3**), and expulsions to the Juvenile Justice Alternative Education (JJAEP) (**Table 4**).

- After a 1.5 percent decline in in-school suspensions in 2009–2010 to 50,462 from 51,222 in 2008–2009, in-school suspensions increased in 2010–2011 to 52,309, a 2.1 percent increase over 2009–2010.
- Out-of-school suspensions declined significantly in 2010–2011 to 38,627, a 14.4 percent reduction compared to 45,115 in 2009–2010.
- Removals to DAEP increased slightly in 2010–2011 to 3,737, a 1.2 percent increase over the 3,691 total for 2009–2010.
- Expulsions to the JJAEP have declined steadily, from 184 in 2008–2009, to 158 in 2009–2010, and to 110 in 2010–2011.

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide the number and rate of student disciplinary incidents that occurred in HISD during the 2010–2011 school year. The report was created to comply with Senate Bill 1724, as described in Section 39.053 of the Texas Education Code. Specifically, it states that the annual report must include a statement of the number, rate, and type of violent or criminal incidents that occurred on each district campus, information concerning school violence prevention and violence intervention policies and procedures that the district is using to protect students, and the findings that result from evaluations conducted under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. Section 7101 et seq.) and its subsequent amendments.

The disciplinary reason codes listed in the report are presented below along with their definitions. The data were obtained from summer 2010–2011 PEIMS summer resubmission file submitted to the Texas Education Agency. The rate was calculated by dividing the number of incidents that occurred by the fall enrollment during 2010–2011 school year.

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide the number and rate of student disciplinary incidents that occurred in HISD during the 2010–2011 school year. The report was created to comply with Senate Bill 1724, as described in Section 39.053 of the Texas Education Code. Specifically, it states that the annual report must include a statement of the number, rate, and type of violent or criminal incidents that occurred on each district campus, information concerning school violence prevention and violence intervention policies and procedures that the district is using to protect students, and the findings that result from evaluations conducted under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. Section 7101 et seq.) and its subsequent amendments.

The disciplinary reason codes listed in the report are presented below along with their definitions. The data were obtained from summer 2010–2011 PEIMS summer resubmission file submitted to the Texas Education Agency. The rate was calculated by dividing the number of incidents that occurred by the fall enrollment during 2010–2011 school year.
