Tasks will be set on the Google Classroom for completion. These tasks are for you to develop your mathematical numerical skills and to practise work completed in lessons. We are also approaching end of year national testing so revision of your work from this year should also be completed. (pupils have their username and passwords)	Two poems will be posted on Google classroom. One poem will be selected from the WJEC anthology, which we are covering in lessons. The other poem will be unseen. The task will be to compare both of these poems through a written response. If you complete this response, your class teacher will mark it and give you written and verbal feedback on your work. This task is designed to best prepare you for year 10.
