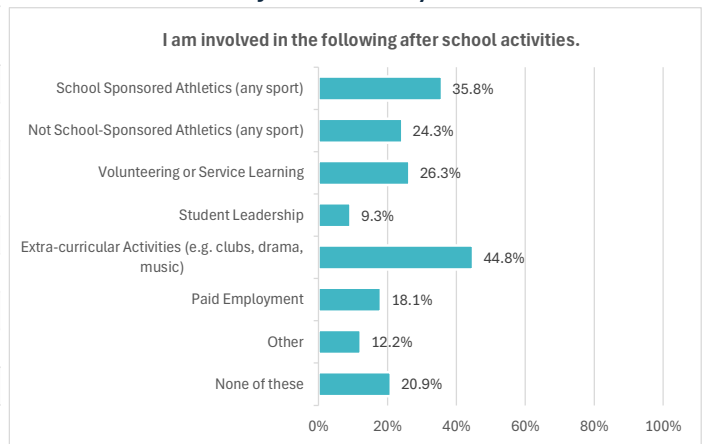

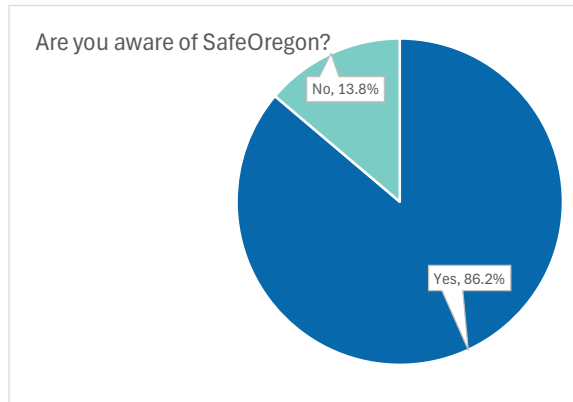

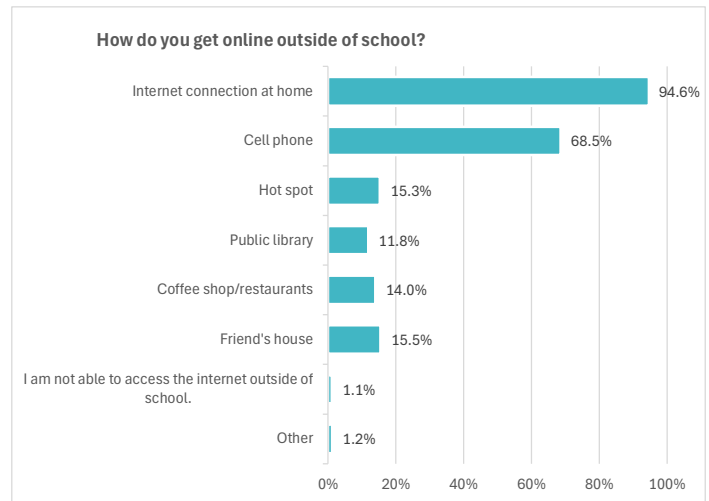

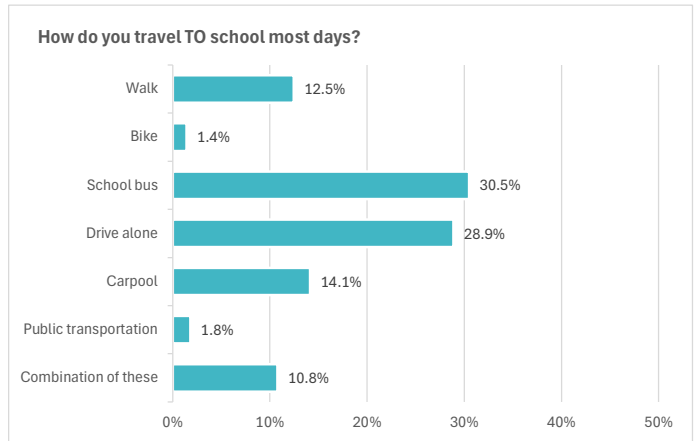

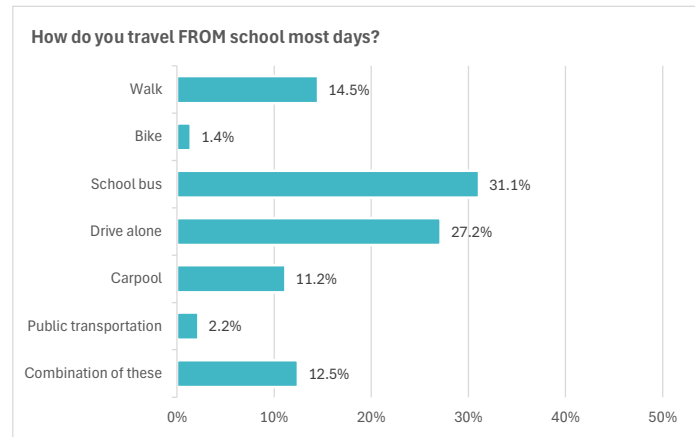

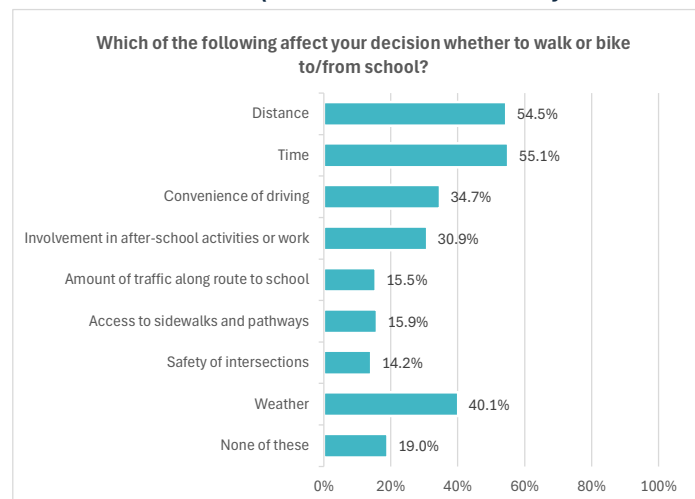


Which of the following affect your decision whether to walk or bike to/from school? (More than one answer may be selected.)

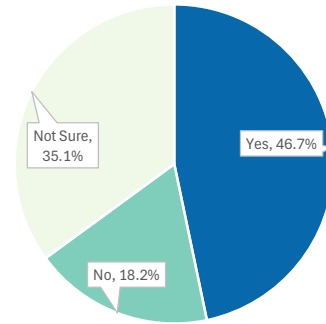

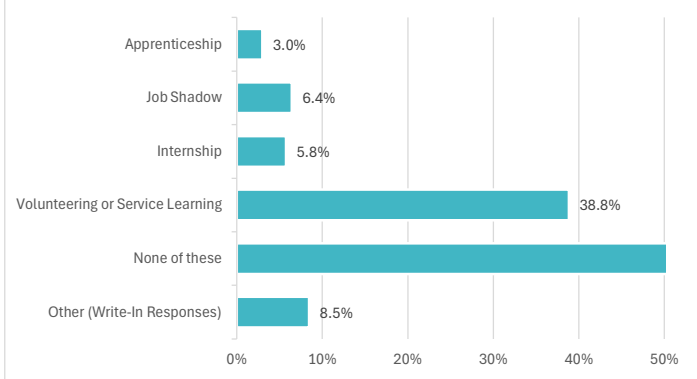

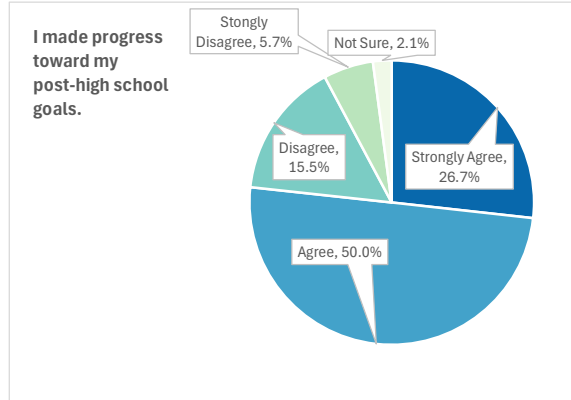

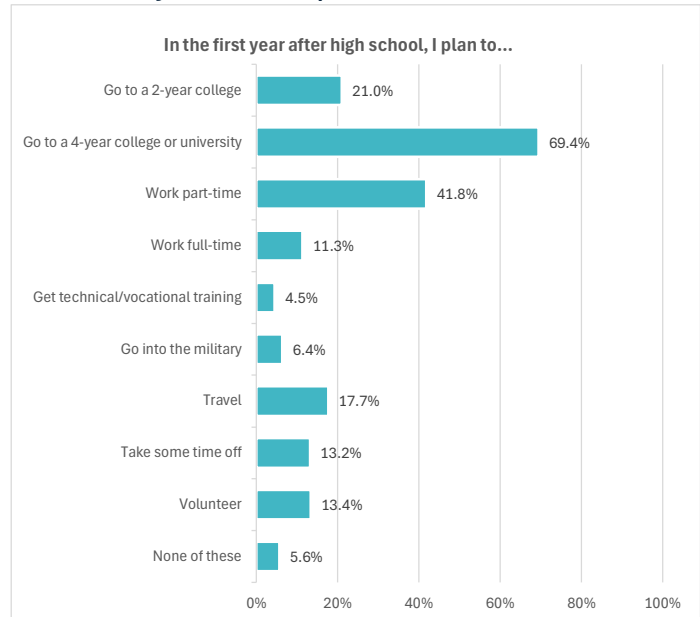
