7.1 Election Reports

8.0 New Business

8.1 Review and Approve Budget Modifications

Mr. Garcia presented the SPSA to display the budget. Mr. Garcia proposed decreasing \$500 from Title I object code 1100-10 to add \$500 to Teacher Collaboration EWAs in object code 1100-30. Mr. Garcia also suggested moving \$3,250 from Object Code 4300 to Object Code 5820 to cover negative balance. In CSI, Mr. Garcia mentioned decreasing \$669.15 from materials and supplies and Object Code 4300 to 5850 to cover negative balance. Lastly in LCFF, \$14,000 will be moved to Object Code 4300 for materials and supplies while \$10,000 will decrease from 5850 and \$4,000 from 5800 to fund PBIS activities.
