Positive Impacts of the Regional Safe School Program.


The Regional Safe School Program can have two types of positive impacts on students:

FY23 AUDIT/AFR

- FY23 draft AFR is complete
- FY23 Audit is near completion
 Remaining issues re: ESSER Grant funds
 - Some duplication of reported expenditures
 - ISBE has agreed to re-open grant expenditure report
 - Efforts to minimize any possible need to return grant funds to ISBE



FY23 AUDIT/AFR

- FY23 Audit confirmed that SEDOL will receive a 'clean opinion'
- SEDOL will receive a letter emphasizing need for improved internal controls
- SEDOL is transitioning to the Skyward
 Financial System focusing on advancing an accurate, transparent accounting process



FY23 Ending Balances

- EDUCATION FUND Approximately \$15.7M or 4 months of current year expenses
- OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE FUND \$5.5M that included \$2 million for Fairhaven School purchase in July, 2023 and ongoing construction projects



FY23 Ending Balances

- DEBT SERVICE \$180,000 ending balance. Fund is self-sufficient.
- TRANSPORTATION Approximately \$1M ending balance or 1.5 years
- IMRF Approximately \$2.5M ending balance due to IMRF rate decreases.
 Reduced levy by 50% in FY24 & 25.



FY23 Audit

- SEDOL business office has begun providing data for the FY24 audit.
- Anticipated completion of FY 24 Audit/AFR -May/June, 2025



Key Summary Points

- FY23 SEDOL Audit is near completion
- SEDOL anticipates positive resolution regarding ESSER expenditures in collaboration with ISBE representatives
- SEDOL anticipates an accurate FY23 Fund Balance
- Anticipated FY24 audit completion by end of current fiscal year
- Financial system changes will provide greater assurances and transparencies
