As the governor proposes total budget \$942,816 cut 24% reduction

FTE- \$105,000/ teacher average

BPO- \$68,000

Need to make planning and marketing decisions
Motion to release to our parents?
Reach out to other charter schools
Send out information to parents
Classroom size- permitted for 34-39
Looking to lose 9 FTE
What would that look like? About 38/39 kids per classroom
If we cut positions lose the least experienced

Superintendent will be sending out communication

1100 teachers will be pink slipped in the proposed budget

Givey liquidate our surplus
Could change the law to take it
Would the landlord take it?

Barr- Recommend to increase student activity fee

What will the communication be to the parents be?
Worst case scenario?
What is the call to action? Protection for charter environment?
