

Culture-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Oct 27 Zoom meeting with Herr Radke and German Consul General Oliver Schramm and Deputy Elena Simms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The German representatives gave us an overview of their areas of responsibility, which include networking in many different forms, and supporting German communities on the west coast. ○ A main discussion point were possible funding options for Rilke Schule; we were presented with different options, the most interesting/lucrative one being the "Immersion support fund". The deputy consul requested more written information regarding Rilke Schule's program and German testing plan, which was submitted to them via e-mail on 11/1 (largely based on our school profile at https://www.pasch-net.de/de/pasch-schulen/schulportraits/nordamerika/usa/rilke-schule.html)

<p>Sustainability- Finances</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 2022/23 FY Budget Proposal (<i>proposed executive session</i>) ● Enrollment recruitment event for December 4th- waiting for final ASD approvals and contract from photographer for approval ● ACS Mesh Roof Top Antenna Network- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Proposal from ACS via our landlord to install an antenna(s) on our roof. The electrical requirement is listed as approximately a light bulb use, so it would not substantially impact our electrical use. After installation, it would not result in disruption to school operations. ○ We would receive a signing bonus of \$1,000, an annual payment of \$1,000, and a monthly payment of \$500. The term is 5 years with automatic renewal. ○ Walkthrough with ACS and landlord conducted 11/17- Rilke rooftop/facility. Once the official paperwork is completed ACS will send it over to the landlord for the final decision.




Cumulative Expenditures 2020/21 vs. 2021/22
