12/20: Grades 4 and 5 will have bagged lunches for their theatre field trip, and grades 1, 2, and 3 will have Bosco sticks for lunch.

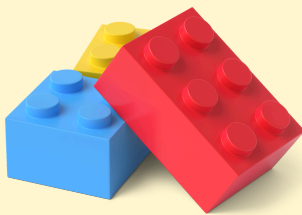


GUIDANCE WITH MR. M
