The class attempts to score as many points as possible and a scoreboard is used to keep track. This way students can practice math and basketball at the same time. They also have begun a hockey unit. 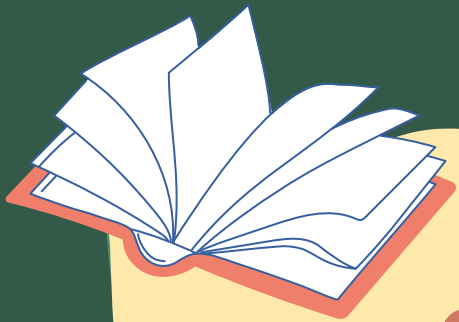

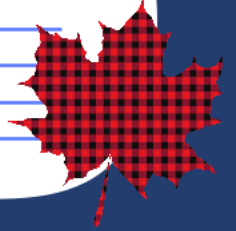
