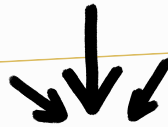
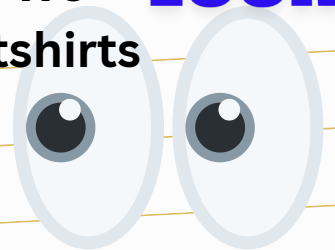

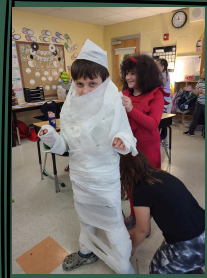

LCS NEWS



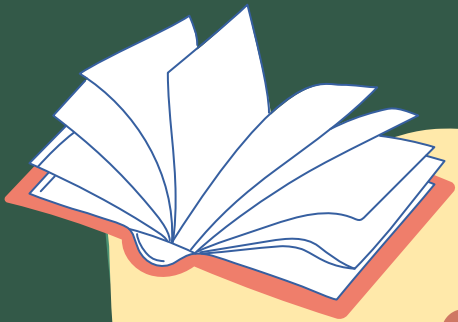
We had a spooktacular week at LCS!

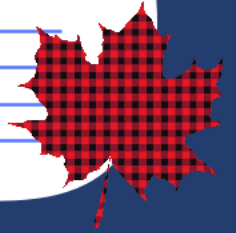
