It's great to be back from our Spring Break! We hope you spent some time outside with friends and family enjoying the warm weather. While rejuvenating for the remainder of the school year!

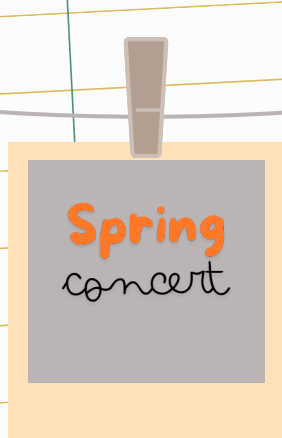

Tuesday, we practiced another fire drill with Chief Nourse. Staff and students performed this drill effortlessly and efficiently. Great job everyone!

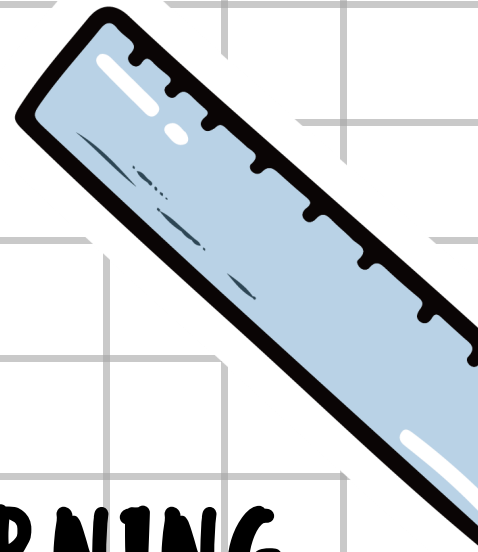
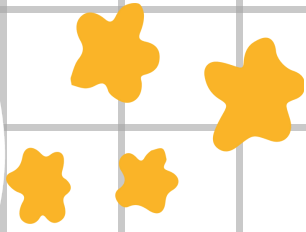
