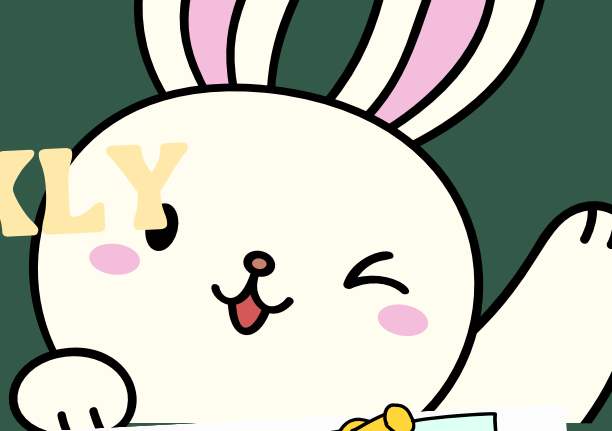

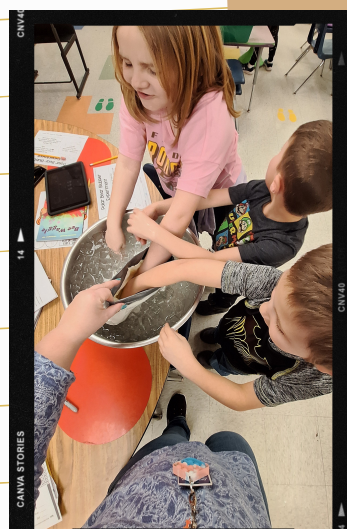

Have a great weekend and enjoy the holiday.

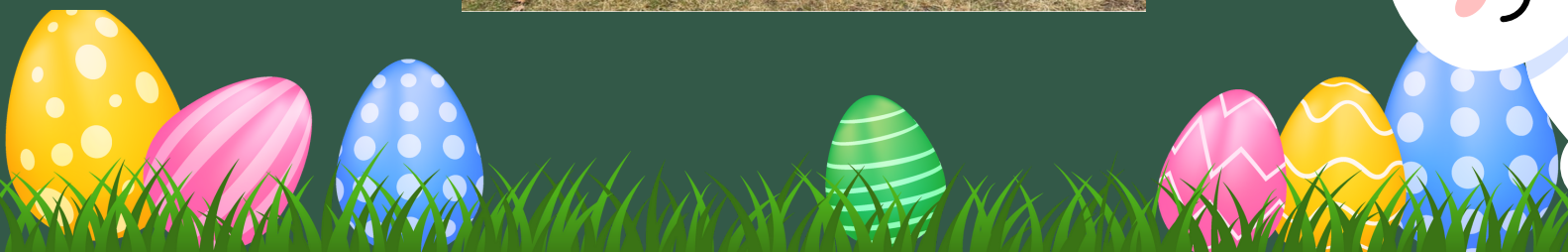
FIRST GRADE EXPERIMENTS

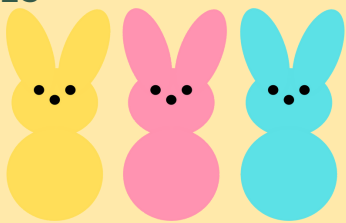
RISE PROGRAM
