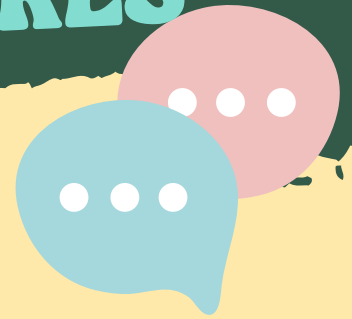

WITH MRS. BERUBE AND MRS. SHERRY

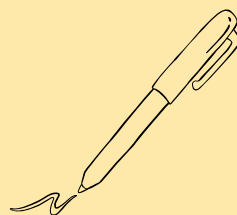
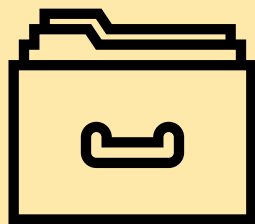


This week we would like to highlight the front office help at FRES and LCS.

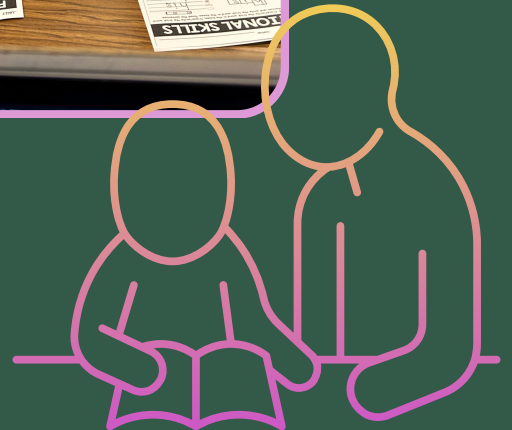
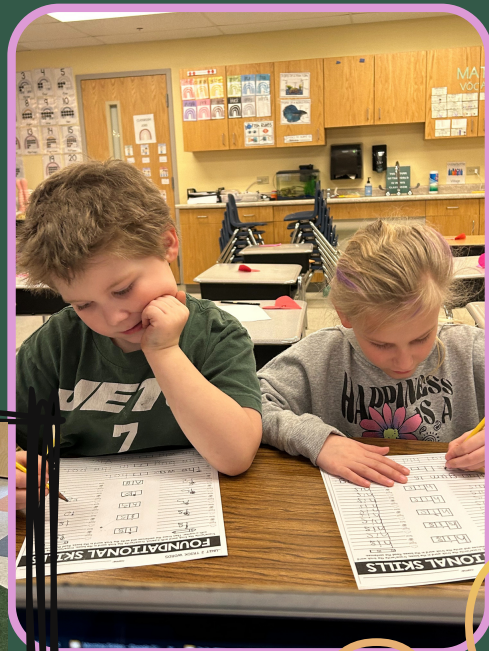

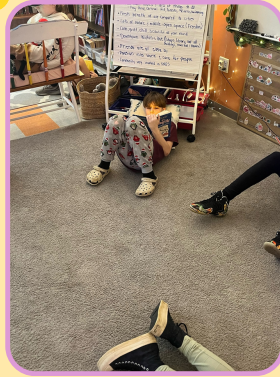
