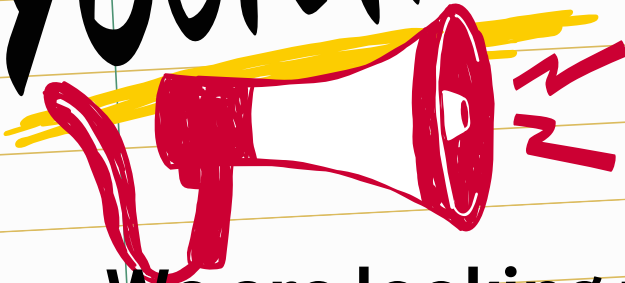

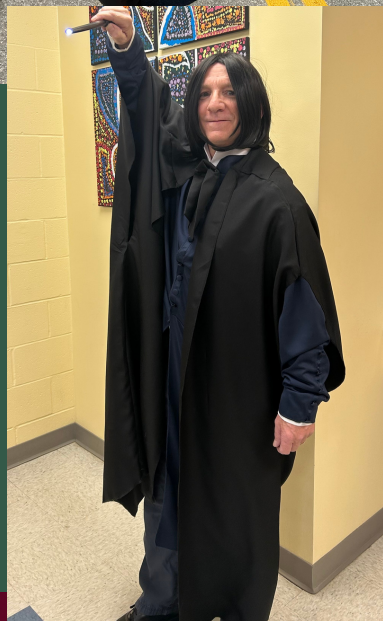

# SPECIAL EDUCATION

WITH MS DAILEY, MS LEVESQUE  
AND MS ROBERTS

Meet the special education case managers, Mrs. Dailey, Mrs. Levesque, and Mrs. Roberts. Our job has two parts: teaching and case managing.

The Special Education team at FRES works hard everyday, providing services to students in math, reading, and writing. Small groups are honing their skills in a variety of ways: learning centers, games and interactive lessons, along with intervention lessons. All are incorporated in lesson plans each day to assist our students and the team in discovering what learning style works best for each student. Students are assessed to determine what areas to focus on for specialized instruction. Some of the programs we use are Heggerty, LIPS, Foundations, Wilson, and Envisions.

We also evaluate students for new referrals to special education, 3 year re-evaluations for existing students in special education, and any other evaluations that may be necessary. Fun fact, we also evaluate students referred to special education from The Pine Hill School at High Mowing. We attend numerous meetings for referrals, evaluation reviews, eligibility, IEP development, and amendments.

We love working with our students and watching them grow!

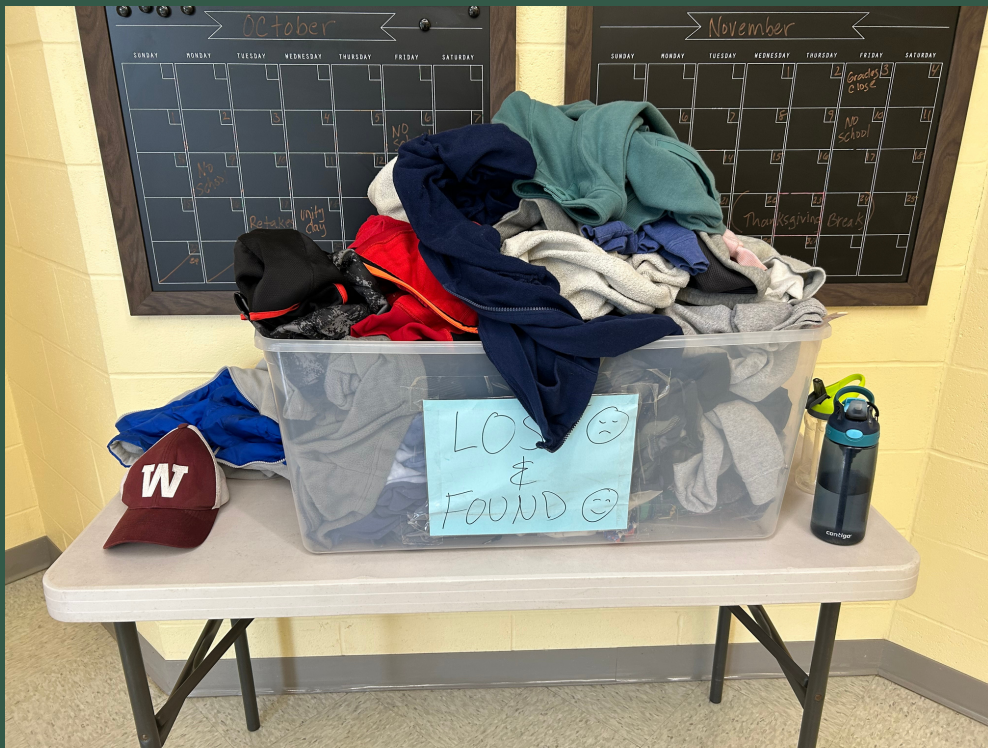
