Congratulations to 5th Grade for raising the most points at 31,523! The entire school raised \$2500.00.

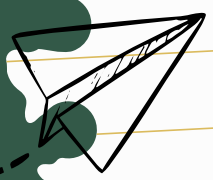
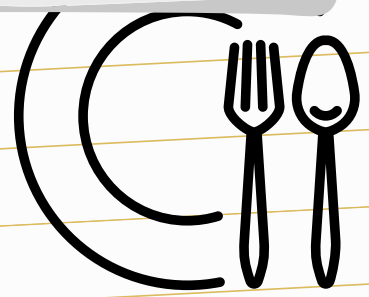
Tuesday, we were entertained by the TIGER performers from Plymouth State University. Thank you!

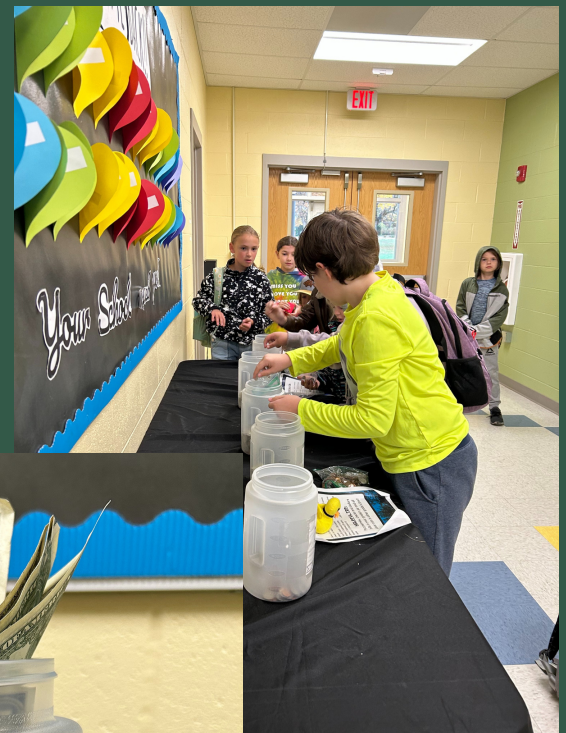

Menu change for October 31st... There will be only one option because of the Halloween Parade. Bagged sandwiches.

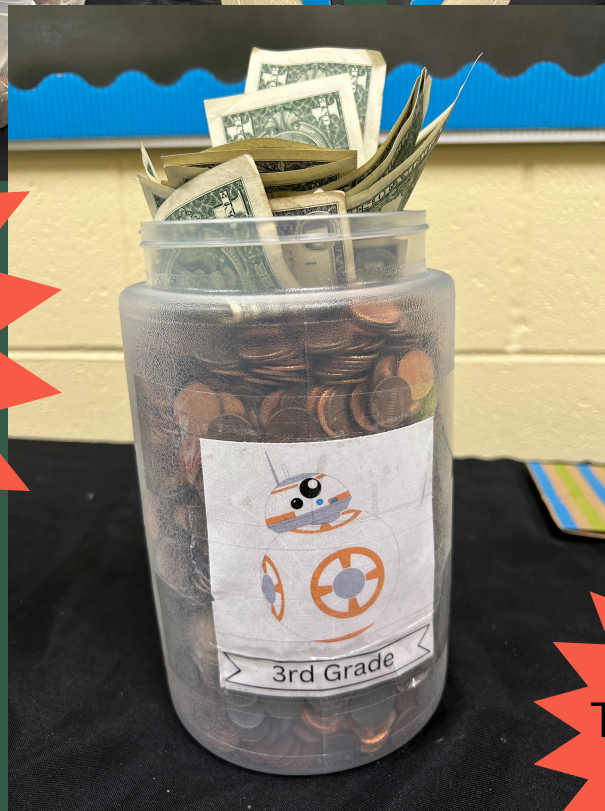

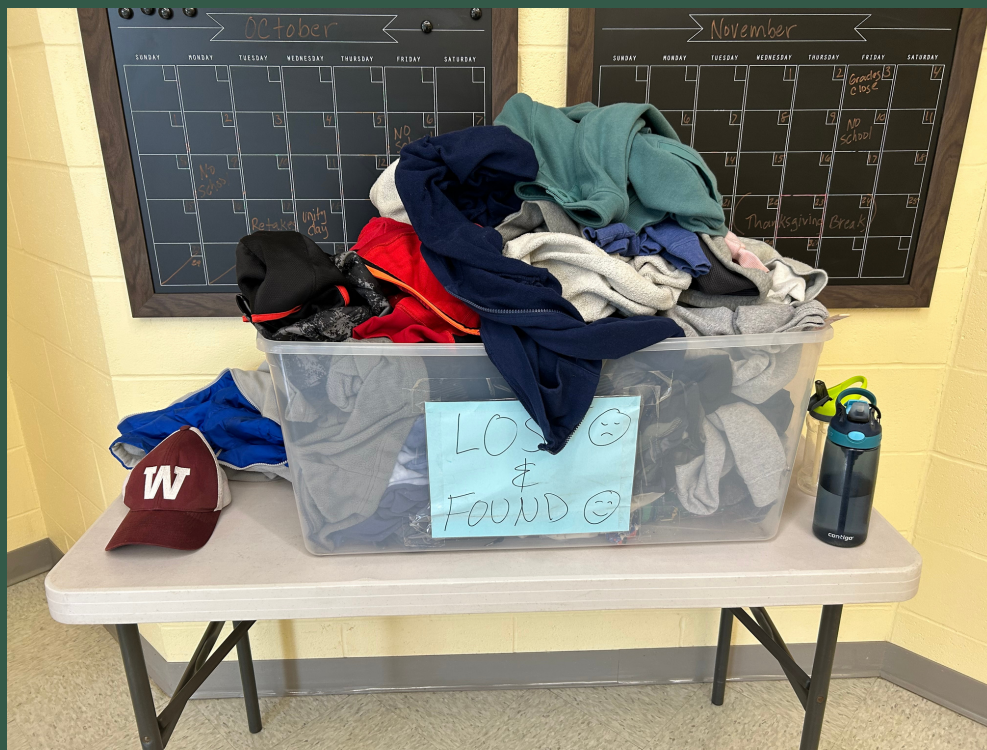
