This week at LCS



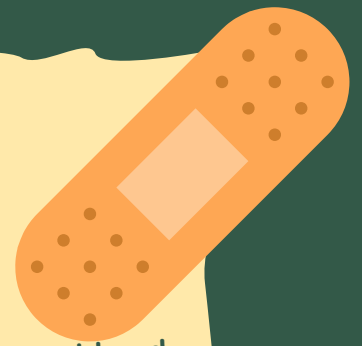

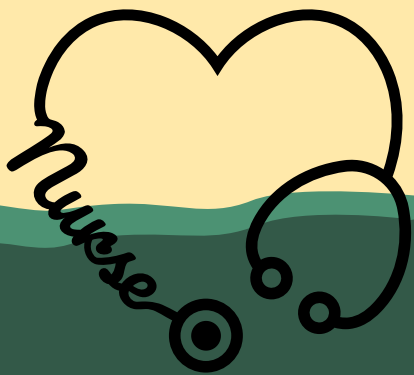
Hello LCS and FRES Families!

Do you feel that in the air? Fall is in full swing! Unfortunately, that means that cold and flu season is here. Whether your child is new to our schools or not, schools tend to be the main platform for the exchange of germs. We in the health offices at both LCS and FRES encourage you to practice good hygiene with your children including, but not limited to: hand washing, covering coughs and sneezes, as well as providing personal space from their peers. Most classrooms are equipped with hand sanitizer and the teachers in both locations are BIG fans of handwashing when needed.

Although the “hype” of COVID-19 has diminished somewhat, we still have policies in place for when your child is ill that need to be followed. One of these policies states that your child must stay home if they have a fever greater than 100.4 F and may only return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications such as tylenol, motrin, or other over the counter medicines. Although, we cannot enforce COVID testing, it is still recommended at this time especially if there is a known exposure. Please visit the SAU63 district website for a full list of all health related policies and procedures for your education, and as always, you can also contact your building’s health office to speak with the nurse for any questions or concerns you may have.

FRIENDLY REMINDER: With the cold weather, please make sure you are sending your child in with weather appropriate clothing. Sweatshirts, jackets, and pants are recommended for the season we are in; the schools do carry extra clothing, but this is limited by quantity and size. If you are in need of any of these items please reach out to the front desk and your request will be handled discreetly.
