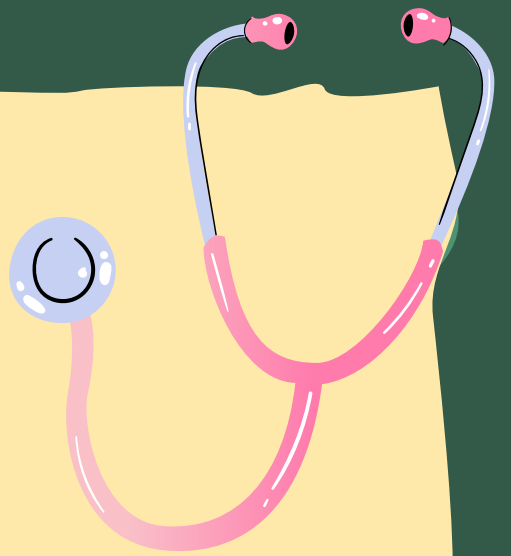

SCHOOL NURSE NEWS!



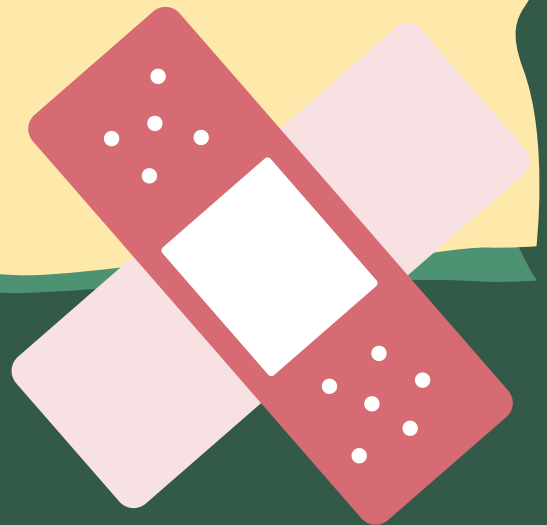
Hello LCS and FRES Families!
