# An Open Letter to the Governor Mifflin School District Community The 2024-2025 Evaluation Summary for Dr. Lisa Hess, Superintendent

One of the primary responsibilities of a school board is the hiring and annual evaluation of the Superintendent. In accordance with this responsibility—and pursuant to legislation requiring annual public notice summarizing the evaluation—on behalf of the Governor Mifflin School District Board of School Directors, I submit the following summary of the evaluation for Dr. Lisa Hess, Superintendent of Schools.

The 2024–2025 school year marked the completion of Dr. Hess's second year in the role of Superintendent. Based on the successful achievement of both quantitative and qualitative goals, and supported by a substantial body of evidence and data, the Board affirms that Dr. Hess has demonstrated exceptional leadership. Her accomplishments during the evaluation period include, but are not limited to, the following:

# • Mission, Vision, and Values Alignment
