LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

Year 1 are loving their English lessons at the moment! The children have been reading 'Diary of a Killer Cat' and have enjoyed learning about diaries and making a timeline of the week. They are enjoying the cheeky and mischievous main character, Tuffy. The children have come up with some excellent words to describe Tuffy and have been writing a character description.

Ask me: What adjectives describe Tuffy?







Year 2 have been enjoying the traditional tale of Rapunzel and comparing it to an alternative version. They have made predictions and responded to illustrations. In science, they have started their new project 'Animal Survival' and have been focussing on habits and microhabitats. The highlight of the week for most was walking to Pizza Express to make their own pizzas.

Ask me: What is a micro habitat?







Year 3 have finished their Romans project this week with researching a Roman site located in the South-East of England. They summarised what it was used for during the time period and marked its location on the map. They also learnt about the legacy of the Roman era and the inventions that we still use today. In jigsaw, we learnt about babies and considered all the things a parent needs to do to take care of a baby.

Ask me: What did the Romans invent?



Year 4 have had a busy week. They have started their new maths topic and are enjoying learning about shapes and angles. In PE we have started baseball and despite the rain, enjoyed an active baseball lesson in the school hall. In jigsaw the children completed their 'Changing Me' lessons. The children listened, asked really sensible questions, had a small giggle at times but were incredibly mature and respectful.

Reception took part in a sports festival run by the Windsor Sports Partnership where we completed a carousel of different sports activities involving skipping, throwing, kicking, rolling and running as well as practising our team work skills. We have also started our new project On the Beach and enjoyed a 'beach day' on the playground.
