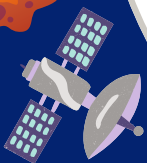
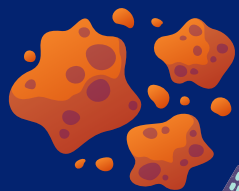
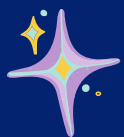


 **Mission: Clue Star**
