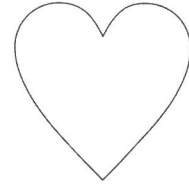


# Welcome to Homeroom 1306!

## About Our Classrooms

We welcome you and your child to our 6-9 Montessori community. This year, our 6-9 Montessori community will be located in rooms 1306 and 1323. We are excited that the children will benefit from having TWO teachers, who provide specialized instruction. Ms. Emily will teach Language and Science, while Ms. Tracey will teach Math and Social Studies. Students will transition in groups between our two rooms each day. In this manner, classes receive specialized instruction, while continuing to apply and use Montessori principles and materials, in each of those content areas. We are fortunate to have a paraprofessional in each homeroom. Our paraprofessionals are Ms. Angie and Ms. Christine and they assist with classroom routines and instruction.

**Personal Supply Box-** Please prepare ahead of time and label with your student's name. You will need a supply box big enough to fit the following supplies:

- 1 pack of #2 writing pencils
- 2 pink bar erasers
- 2 black dry erase markers
- 1 sock (this will be your marker eraser- can be an old mismatched sock)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 4 glue sticks

**Personal Supplies**

- Headphones in a Ziploc bag (labeled with your student's name). We use these everyday.
- Water bottle
- Simple soled house slippers- low distraction (optional)

**Community Supplies-** These supplies will be shared in order to build cooperation and foster the Montessori Philosophy.

- 1 black wide ruled composition notebook (**2<sup>nd</sup>** and **3<sup>rd</sup>** graders only)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 cans of disinfectant wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 Plastic Folder (see color for each grade) **1st:** Green, **2nd:** Blue, **3rd:** Red

- Extra black dry erase markers
- Extra glue sticks
- Masking/painter's tape
- Hand sanitizer
- Indoor plants that do not need much sunlight
