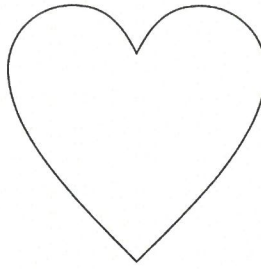

Personal Supply Box- Please prepare ahead of time and label with your student's name. You will need a supply box big enough to fit the following supplies:
